#### I. Attendance

#### III. Old / New Business

##### A. Old Business

##### 1. Review and approval of the June 15, 2020 meeting minutes

A motion to approve the June 15, 2020 minutes was offered by Pat Magrogan and seconded by Pat Walker; the minutes were approved unanimously.

##### 2. Discuss 2020 legislative funding

The following itemized project funding was included within the proposed state budget:

1. Pennock Industrial Park Stormwater Improvement / Town of Jupiter = **\$150,000** (requested \$231,855)
2. Cypress Creek Floodplain Restoration Project Phase 1 / Martin County = **\$100,000** (requested \$125,000)
3. Section 7 Drainage Improvements / South Indian River Water Control District (SIRWCD) = **\$150,000** (requested \$321,500)
4. Seminole Avenue Stormwater Basin / Town of Jupiter = **\$250,000** (requested \$870,000)
5. Sims Creek Preserve Hydrologic Restoration / Town of Jupiter = **\$150,000** (requested \$350,000)

**Total Requested = \$1,898,355 / Total Appropriated = \$800,000**

Deb Drum, Palm Beach County ERM, relayed the unfortunate news that the Governor vetoed all LRPI funding included within the proposed state budget as referenced above, due to state budget concerns related to COVID-19.

## 2. Letter of appreciation

Don Donaldson, Martin County, motioned to the committee that a letter of appreciation to the legislative delegation still be presented for their efforts to support the LRPI projects for funding. Don Donaldson agreed to provide the draft letter to Nestor Garrido for distribution to the committee members for review and feedback. Committee members received direction to provide comments or suggested edits through email to Nestor no later than Friday, July 10, 2020. Compiled suggestions will go to the Chair, for final review, signature, and distribution. A motion to proceed as noted was offered by Pat Walker and seconded by Deb Drum.
