




# Project Area - Inlet Dredging and Placement Areas




<u>Beach Placement Template</u> R-13 to R-19 Total Permitted Length Berm Width 115' to 279'

Includes Dune, Berm, and Slope Dune Elevation +12.5' Berm Elevation +7.5'








- Currently Maintaining Navigation at Inlet




















# <u>Jupiter Inlet District 2020</u> Dredging Status - Summary
