Don Donaldson of Martin County offered to the committee that Martin County's project assume the number 2 ranking as it is a very positive project but is not yet ready for construction.

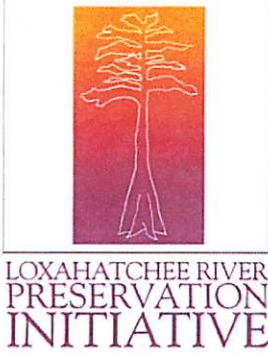
5. Other Business
