Step 4: Audit & Strengthen Your Board Bio

- Exercise: Review Your Current Bio (or Write a First Draft!)
- Does your opening statement clearly state your governance expertise?
- Is your experience framed in a board-relevant way (governance, strategy, financial oversight)?
- Do you include risk, innovation, and leadership skills?
