This Privacy Policy explains how Ryehill Community Ventures collects and uses your personal information. We encourage you to read this policy carefully.

## 1. OUR COMMITMENT

Ryehill Community Ventures is committed to respecting your privacy and ensuring the personal information you have entrusted to us is held securely. We process personal information in accordance with General Data Protection Regulations 2018 (GDPR).

## 2. CONTROLLERS AND PROCESSORS

A data controller determines the purposes and means of processing personal data. A data processor is responsible for processing personal data on behalf of a controller.

When we hold or use your personal information as a data controller we will alert you to this privacy policy and on request provide you with a copy of it. This privacy policy sets out in detail what information we hold about you (such as your contact details, address, etc.), how your personal information may be used and the reasons for these uses, together with details of your rights.

## 3. HOW WE COLLECT PERSONAL INFORMATION

We **may** collect the following personal information from you:

## 9. SECURITY

Ryehill Community Ventures is committed to keeping your personal information safe and to prevent unauthorised access, use, or disclosure of it. Unfortunately, no information transmission over the Internet is guaranteed 100% secure nor is any storage of information always 100% secure, but we do take all appropriate steps to protect the security of your personal information.

## 10. YOUR INFORMATION RIGHTS AND CHOICES

The GDPR gives you the right:

The Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR) gives you the right:

#### 11. COOKIES

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. Ryehill Community Ventures uses cookies to enable our website to function effectively, to improve your experience and to determine and improve the effectiveness of our website and marketing campaigns.

Here is a brief overview of the types of cookies we use on the Ryehill Community Ventures website, which consist of three categories:

- CMS cookies our Ryehill Community Ventures website is created in a CMS (Content Management System) called Go Daddy which places a small number of standard cookies on your computer as you use it.
- Cookies to improve your experience we use a small number of cookies on our website to help you get the best experience.
- Analytics Examples include Google Analytics. Google Analytics cookies collect
  information about how visitors use a website and help us to continually improve our
  website. For instance, which pages visitors go to most often and if they get error messages
  from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies you. All information
  these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. Ryehill Community Ventures

uses this data to help us to understand: which pages people visit on the site, which internet browsers are being used and what is popular on our website.
