



3TG (Conflict Minerals) Statement

Company Name: Saga Machine Company, LLC

At Saga Machine Co. we are committed to responsible sourcing and support the goals of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, specifically Section 1502, which aims to prevent the use of conflict minerals (Tin, Tungsten, Tantalum, and Gold – collectively known as 3TG) that directly or indirectly finance, or benefit armed groups in the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries.

As a CNC machine shop, we do not directly source or purchase raw 3TG minerals from smelters or mines. However, we recognize that components, tools, or raw materials used in our operations may contain 3TG. To the best of our knowledge and based on reasonable due diligence with our suppliers, we strive to ensure that any 3TG contained in the materials we use are sourced responsibly and do not originate from conflict-affected regions.

We require our suppliers to:

- Conduct their own due diligence on the source and chain of custody of 3TG minerals.
- Support responsible sourcing practices and comply with applicable regulations.
- Provide information regarding the presence and source of 3TG in products they supply to us, when requested.

Saga Machine Co. will continue to evaluate its supply chain and encourage responsible mineral sourcing to support ethical business practices across the manufacturing industry.
