


40 DAYS OF

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 25,727,000 // Christians: 300,000

Source of Persecution: Communist and
Post-Communist Oppression

When Christians are discovered, they are arrested and imprisoned in labor camps, where they are worked like slaves and often tortured; most never escape.

PRAY North Korean officials will come to know God, for change within the regime and that the power of evil will be broken.

PRAY that Kim Jong Un, North Korea's leader, will accept the one, true God.

PRAY for Christians who suffer in prisons, labor camps and remote areas.

READ COLOSSIANS 3:12-16

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 37,209,000 // Christians: Thousands

Source of Persecution: Clan and ethnic antagonism

Those who are discovered to be Christians may be sent to a mental hospital—because their families believe no sane person would leave Islam. They may also be beaten or even killed by family members, or members of Islamic extremist groups like the Taliban.

PRAY for Christians, who face heavy pressure from family, friends and neighbors, to have courage and perseverance.

PRAY for a softening of the country's leadership and local rulers which currently doesn't allow conversion from Islam.

PRAY for the spread of the gospel through the underground church.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 37,209,000 // Christians: Thousands

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Conversion to Christianity is regarded as a betrayal of the Somali family and clan. If Somalis are suspected of being converts, family members and clan leaders will harass, intimidate and even kill them.

PRAY The Somali people are more than 99 percent Muslim and society expects all Somalis to be Muslim. Pray God will continue to build His Church amid these hostilities.

PRAY the Somali people in the Horn of Africa turn to God when they go through turmoil. Pray they will have a deep hunger and thirst for the righteousness of God.

PRAY believers are bold to share the gospel.

PRAY for mature and godly role-models and growing unity among Somali believers.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 6,570,000 // Christians: 36,200

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Libyan Christians with a Muslim background face violent and intense pressure to renounce their faith.

There is no freedom of speech, no equal treatment of Christians, no recognition of the church or churches being built.

PRAY for Christians, who face heavy pressure from family, friends and neighbors, to have courage and perseverance.

PRAY for a softening of the country's leadership and local rulers which currently doesn't allow conversion from Islam.

PRAY for the spread of the gospel through the underground church.

Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 204,596,000 // Christians: 4,015,000

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Christians are regarded as second class citizens.

Also, the country's anti-blasphemy laws are disproportionately applied against the Christian minority, making it difficult and dangerous to live out one's faith in public.

PRAY the Pakistani government passes laws that will protect the Christians and other religious minorities in the country.

PRAY for peace for those who convert from Islam as they face persecution from family, friends and neighbors.

PRAY Christians accused under blasphemy laws will not face violence or mob "justice."

PRAY for protection of Christian women and girls who are often raped and then forcefully married to Muslim men.

Population: 5,310,000 // Christians: 2,492,000

Source of Persecution: Christian denominational protectionism

Hundreds of Christians who are members of unregistered churches are in prison; some have been held captive for over a decade.



PRAY for endurance for brothers and sisters detained or imprisoned in horrific conditions, and ask God to give them perseverance in their faith.

PRAY for government leaders in Eritrea, that God would work in their hearts and reveal the truth of the gospel.

PRAY for unity among Christians in Eritrea, to help them see past denominationalism and count themselves as one.

Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3

READ COLOSSIANS 1:14-20

FOCUS He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. 
Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Recently, the government has arrested or intimidated many Christian leaders, and numerous churches have been demolished. Extremists have attacked, displaced or killed Christians in the Nuba Mountains.

PRAY for peace and expanded religious freedom in Sudan as negotiations continue between the military council and opposing forces.

PRAY for Christians to have the opportunity to worship together freely without fear of violence.

PRAY for new converts to Christianity, that they would be able to stand strong and have access to Bibles and discipleship training.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 29,580,000 // Christians: A few thousand

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

An ongoing civil war in Yemen has created one of the worst humanitarian crises in recent memory, allowing radical Islamic groups to expand their operations in certain areas, leading to Christians being abducted and killed.

PRAY for peace in Yemen as opposing forces continue to clash and leave Christians vulnerable.

PRAY The instability in Yemen has created a refugee, food and healthcare crisis. Ask God to help provide food, clean water, and relief to the people of Yemen.

PRAY that the secret believers from Muslim backgrounds will have courage and perseverance in their faith—along with Bibles and discipleship materials.

READ ZEPHANIAH 2:1-3

FOCUS Seek the Lord, all you humble of the earth, who carry out what he commands. Seek righteousness, seek humility; perhaps you will be concealed on the day of the Lord's anger. Zephaniah 2:3

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 82,821,000 // Christians: 800,000

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Christians are forbidden from sharing their faith

with non-Christians, and it is illegal to produce

Christian literature or hold church services in Farsi.

Christians in underground churches face constant threat of arrest.



PRAY for Iranian Christians who are in prison right now for their faith. Ask God to give them hope and encouragement in their isolation.

PRAY that God will work through the leaders in Iran to create laws that provide more religious freedom for Christians and minority religions.

PRAY for secret believers who meet in house churches to be protected and to be faithful witnesses.

READ PSALM 67

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 1,368,738,000 // Christians: 66,194,000

Source of Persecution: Religious nationalism

Converts to Christianity from Hindu backgrounds or tribal religions are often extremely persecuted by their family members and communities.

PRAY for Christian converts from Hinduism and tribal religions who are forcefully pressured to return to their former religion.

PRAY for God's power and protection over Christians as they preach the gospel in places with anti-conversion laws.

PRAY for the government leaders of India, that they would change their perspective and create more room for religious freedom.



Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3



READ 1 PETER 5:1-11

FOCUS Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God, so that He may exalt you at the proper time, casting all your cares on Him, because He cares about you. 1 Peter 5:6-7

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

Christians are caught in the crossfire between government troops and rebel forces, especially at the frontlines. Additionally, Christians are at risk if forces antagonistic to Christianity rule their home regions.



PRAY for peace for Syria and ask God to relieve the suffering of Christians in hostile regions held by rebel groups who oppose Christianity.

PRAY for critical relief and aid to reach Christians who have fled their homes or lack basic resources in their cities.

PRAY for Syrian church leaders to have wisdom, perseverance, and discernment as they lead their people and provide hope.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 200,962,000 // Christians: 93,791,000

Source of Persecution: Islamic Oppression

Christians in the northern region and in the Middle Belt suffer from violence by Islamic extremist groups such as Hausa-Fulani and Boko Haram. Such violence often results in loss of life, physical injury, and loss of property.

PRAY for Christians who live in constant threat of attacks by Islamic extremists. Ask God to protect them and give them hope and peace.

PRAY for Fulani militants and other extremist groups like Boko Haram. Pray that God will touch their hearts with the truth of the gospel.

PRAY for pastors and church leaders who are helping rebuild communities and restore their churches after violent attacks.

All Saudi citizens are required to be Muslim, and non-citizens of other faiths are expected to worship privately. Christians who have converted from Islam risk violence because of their decision to follow Jesus.

PRAY for isolated believers all over Saudi Arabia, who lack fellowship and community. They need discipleship and a sense of belonging.

PRAY Christian Saudis will find ways to share the truth with their own family members.

PRAY It is forbidden to openly practice religions other than Islam—conversion is punishable by death. Please pray Muslim Saudis will come to know Jesus.

FOCUS In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Genesis 1:1

Churches are outlawed, and openly carrying the Bible is illegal. The country is so tightly controlled by Islamic law that there is not even a Bible fully translated into the native language of most citizens of the Maldives.

PRAY Official policy dictates every citizen must be Muslim. Pray that God would work in the hearts of leaders to change this law.


PRAY that God would lead secret believers to find fellowship with one another and access to the Bible.

PRAY Local media reports that drug abuse has become the biggest social issue there. Pray that Maldivians will turn to Jesus to experience true freedom.

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 40,412,000 // Christians: 202,000

Source of Persecution: Islamic Oppression

Many Iraqi Christians are still recovering from the brutal reign of ISIS, and for some believers, that threat has not fully diminished. ISIS still has places of safety in northern Iraq.

PRAY for Christians who are rebuilding their communities and churches in Iraq. Pray for trauma recovery and reconstruction efforts, that God would give peace to believers.

PRAY Thank God that pressure and violence have both decreased slightly. Ask God to give His hope to Christians in Iraq.

PRAY priests and pastors who are leading diminished communities will find encouragement for the hard work ahead, that they would know they aren't alone.

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

There are violent attacks in Egypt that make news headlines, but also more subtle forms of duress for Christians. Particularly in rural areas, Christians have been chased from villages, subject to mob violence and intense pressure.

PRAY for believers who have friends or family who have been injured or killed in violent attacks. Pray for healing of hearts, minds, and bodies.

PRAY for unity in the Egyptian church, that Christians of all backgrounds would see themselves as a common family of God.

PRAY that God would soften the hearts of extremists and government leaders, and Jesus' name would be known.

READ REVELATION 21

DAY

FOCUS The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, because the glory of God illuminates it, and its lamp is the Lamb. PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 42,679,000 // Christians: 129,000

Source of Persecution: Islamic oppression

The most visible example of persecution in 2019 was the seemingly systemic closure of Protestant churches. In some of these cases, Christians were forcibly expelled by police in the middle of church services.

PRAY with the believers who have had their churches shut down. Pray for the pastors, that they would feel God's presence.

PRAY for Christians who convert from Islam, that they would be protected, bold, and wise.

PRAY with believers who are rejected by their families for their faith. Pray that God would let them know they have a global family who stands with them through prayer.



Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3

DAY

READ PHILIPPIANS 2:1-11

FOCUS Do nothing out of selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility consider others as more important than yourselves. Philippians 2:3

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 32,807,000 // Christians: 349,000

Source of Persecution: Dictatorial paranoia

Since the culture is largely Muslim, Christians who convert from Islam face pressure and violence from their families and communities. Christian women from Islamic backgrounds often face forced marriage and sexual violence.

PRAY that Christian converts from Islam would be delivered from threats of violence from their family and communities.

PRAY with Christian groups who are targeted by the government because they are not sanctioned by the state. Pray for safety and for courage.

PRAY for the isolated believers who have converted from Islam and are unable to publicly express their faith.

Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3

READ PSALM 139



FOCUS For it was you who created my inward parts; you knit me together in my mother's womb. I will praise you because I have been remarkably and wondrously made. Your works are wondrous, and I know this very well. Psalm 139:13-14

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 54,336,000 // Christians: 4,322,000

Source of Persecution: Religious nationalism
Buddhist extremists maintain that to be Burmese—the majority ethnic group—is to be Buddhist, so there is intense pressure on all religious minorities, including Christians.

PRAY for persecuted Christian minorities, that they would lovingly minister to persecuted Rohingya Muslims, especially those choosing to return from exile in Bangladesh. Pray that many hearts would be opened to the truth of Christ.

PRAY Christians who convert from Buddhism and Islam live under intense pressure from their families and communities. Pray for them to feel connected to the Church of God around the world.



Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3

READ COLOSSIANS 3:12-17

FOCUS Therefore, as God's chosen ones, holy and dearly loved, put on compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. Colossians 3:12

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED CHURCH

Population: 7,064,000 // Christians: 227,000
Source of Persecution: Communist and post-communist oppression

Converts to Christianity in Laos face the most severe forms of Christian persecution. Abandoning Buddhism or tribal animist beliefs is seen as a betrayal to family and the community,

LAOS



PRAY that Christians would be able to witness to their Buddhist neighbors and family members, and that they wouldn't be oppressed because of their faith.

PRAY that Christians in Laos would be able to freely access Bibles and register churches. Pray for the salvation of leaders who try to restrict the church.

PRAY that Christian children in Buddhist schools would not be discriminated against low marks because of their faith.

Remember those in prison, as though you were in prison with them, and the mistreated, as though you yourselves were suffering bodily. Hebrews 13:3





PRAY that young people who have increasing access to education may usher in a shift in the climate toward Christians.


PRAY for Christians and other minority groups who face discrimination.

PRAY for Christian converts from Islam as they live under tightening anti-conversion laws. Ask God to give them wisdom and perseverance.


PRAY that God would open the eyes of Muslim extremists and university students exploring radical Islamic ideology to draw them to Himself.

INDONESIA


PRAY for Christians who live in regions where extremist Muslim preachers are creating hatred against followers of Jesus.
