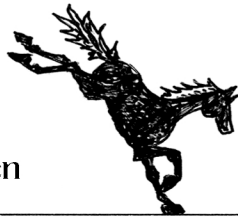
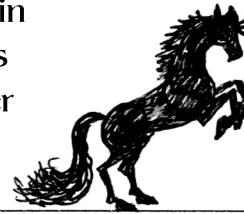


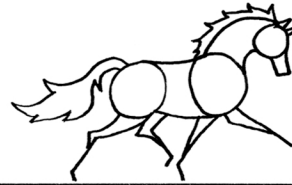
Style #4 -  
ball point pen



These two are done in ball point pen! This creates a bit wilder silhouette.



If you want your pony more "on the bit" - shorten and round the neck and back a little.



Just remember to keep the nose in front of the vertical!

Style #5 - pen



Outline with pen and leave open. Then add details such as four white socks and a rider.

Smaller hooves will give a lighter feel.



Add a horn...



Or wings!!
