## Are You Contagious?

There is a lot of talk about being contagious these days. We are to be very careful about who we are exposed to and who might get exposed to us. Of course we don't want to be contagious in the sense of spreading a virus, but there are some things we should be spreading in our world.

Our **love should be contagious.** The Bible in many places tells us of the importance of love. Jesus called it the greatest commandment (Mk 12:29-31). In 1 Corinthians 13 we are told that we could have all knowledge, power, and make great sacrifices but if we don't love we gain nothing. Love is something we must possess and something we must share.

"And it is my prayer that your love may abound more and more..." (Phil 1:9). Our love is something that is to grow and "abound more and more." When Paul wrote to the Thessalonians he stated that they knew how to love one another, yet he encouraged them to do so more and more (1 Thes. 4:9-10) Our love should be a growing and a spreading love; a love that is infectious.

Our **hope should be contagious.** In 1 Peter 3:15 states, "in your hearts honor Christ the Lord as holy, always being prepared to make a defense to anyone who asks you for a reason for the hope that is in you; yet do it with gentleness and respect." Our hope should be something people are drawn to. It should be noticeable and desirable. The reason why the Christian hope is so contagious is that is based in our great salvation.

Lastly, our **salvation should be contagious.** Throughout the Bible you can read about God's truth and the message of salvation spreading and being shared. We are told to go into all the world and take the message of salvation with us. Read these powerful words, "But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of him everywhere."(2 Cor 2:14). For some the message of salvation is one of life, for others who refuse to accept it is a message of death. Some will listen while others won't yet it is our job to be used by God to spread the beautiful fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere.

Let's be contagious Christians! Let's spread our faith, hope, and love across this world and bring people the life saving message of the cross!
