## 2019-2020 End of Year Report

## June 2020

Last July I attended the International Council Meeting in Sendai, Japan as the Y's Menettes Representative, and then stayed on to attend the Asia Pacific Area Convention, where I met up with many Y's Menettes from the Area. I had planned to attend the International Convention in Denmark this August but, unfortunately, it had to be cancelled due to the Covid-19 Pandemic. Oh well, maybe we can meet up again in 2022 at the International Convention in Hawaii where we will celebrate 100 years of Y's Men's International.

During the year I have written several Newsletters and have communicated with the International Executive Officers and other International Council Members through GoTo Meetings. This has been an excellent project and thanks to our Project Co-ordinator Joy McNamara we have been kept well informed on its progress throughout the two years. There were a couple of unexpected setbacks during this time due to an earthquake which made the building being used unusable, so a new site was found and then Covid-19 hit and everyone went into lockdown for a period of time. We have recently voted on a new project for the coming two years. The successful project is 'Sports and informal education as tools of healthy lifestyle promotion among vulnerable children' based in Zaporizhzhia, Ukraine. It will create an outdoor sports playground with gym equipment in the grounds of the Regional Centre where orphans and poor children are cared for. It will be a community asset.

Joy will be continuing in her role as Y's Menettes International Project Co-ordinator for the new project. Thank you Joy!
