

ASSUMPTION OF RISK,
RELEASE OF CLAIMS, AND HOLD HARMLESS
IMPORTANT! THIS FORM MUST BE COMPLETED FOR PARTICIPATION

I, the undersigned Participant (including parents or legal guardian of Participant, if Participant is under 18 years of age), desire to voluntarily participate in the _____ event hosted by the Vanderbilt University (“Vanderbilt”) _____ student organization/department. The activity will be held on the Vanderbilt campus on _____, 202____. Participants of the event may elect to take part in various physical activities including _____, and other social activities, (each an “activity”).

Participant has voluntarily elected to participate in the activity. Participant understands that Vanderbilt does not guarantee Participant’s safety during participation in the activity and that there are inherent risks of property damage and personal injury to Participant and others that may result from participation. The specific risks may range from minor injuries (e.g., scratches, bruises, and cuts) to catastrophic injuries (e.g., paralysis, and death). Participant understands that injuries or outcomes may arise from Participant’s own or others’ actions, inaction, or negligence; conditions related to any travel or other aspects of participation in the activity; or the condition of the location or premises where the activity is taking place.

Participant understands that Vanderbilt, in its sole discretion, may terminate Participant’s participation in the activity at any time, without notice or cause.

Participant voluntarily assumes the risks related to infectious disease), personal injury, or property damage, by voluntarily participating in this activity. Participant also acknowledges that it is Participant’s responsibility to take precautions to safeguard Participant’s health and safety. Participant understands that the rules and regulations of the activity and of Vanderbilt are designed for the safety and protection of all participants, and Participant hereby agrees to abide by these rules and regulations.

Furthermore, in consideration of Vanderbilt offering this opportunity to participate in this activity, Participant agrees to and hereby does release from fault and discharge Vanderbilt and its trustees, agents, officers, employees, representatives, and servants (the “Parties”) against loss (including reasonable attorneys’ fees), from claims, demands, rights, or causes of action of any kind or nature (“Claims”) to the extent arising from the negligent acts or omissions of Vanderbilt and relating to Participant’s participation in the activity. Without limitation, Claims include those at any time made or brought by Participant, or by any other person having a legal interest thereof, arising from or by reason of known or unknown, foreseen and unforeseen bodily or personal injuries, damages to property and consequences thereof which may be sustained by Participant as a consequence of any accident or injuries in connection with the activity. Further, Participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Parties from Claims relating to participation in the activity.

Participant attests that Participant is physically and mentally capable to participate in the activity. If Participant should suffer an injury or illness while participating in this activity, or any other activity associated with the event, Participant authorizes the parties to use their discretion for transport to a health care facility and Participant takes full legal and financial responsibility for that action and for payment of all care Participant may receive.

Participant further grants and conveys unto Vanderbilt any right, title and interest in any and to all photographic images and video or audio recordings and all copies thereto made of Participant by Vanderbilt during participation in the activity, including but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds or other benefits derived from such photographs or records. Participant understands that Vanderbilt may use such images or recordings for educational or promotional purposes.

This agreement is intended to be broad and inclusive as permitted by the state of Tennessee. If any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, then any such holding shall not affect the validity of the valid portions. This agreement will be construed in accordance with Tennessee law, and Participant agrees to submit to jurisdiction and venue in the state courts of Davidson County, Tennessee.

Vanderbilt Protection of Minors Provision: Vanderbilt University personnel adhere to Tennessee state law on mandatory reporting of actual or suspected child abuse. In addition, to external reporting, Vanderbilt has a mandatory internal child abuse reporting procedure.
