Hide Placement Matters: How to set up training searches that lead to more trial success.

Day 1 Novice-Intermediate Teams

Is your dog going past hides? Are you struggling to read your dog? Does your dog search great at home, but doesn't seem to work at trial? Would you like to have more confidence in your training set-ups?

This seminar will help you learn effective hide placement that challenges your dog while building their hunt drive, independence, and desirable searching behaviors. Handlers will gain practical skills to read your dog more accurately and build trust that carries into trial performance.

Day 2 Advanced Teams

Are you struggling with the increased number or unknown number of hides? Do inaccessible or elevated hides have you questioning how to call alert? Convergence confusion or stuck in a pool of odor?

Come learn how to set hides for success and how to use scent puzzles and patterns to target specific skills, keep your dogs engaged and sharpen your handling strategies. Go home at the end of the day with practical tools to make every training session more effective, fun, and rewarding.

Both days offer hands-on experience for working teams and great opportunity to learn through observation for auditors.

Cost: Working spot \$150 per day; Auditor \$50 (no dog)
