The Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada (SOCAN) is the watchdog that makes sure that composers, authors and music publishers get paid for their work. They do this through the Copyright Act of Canada. Performers, performance venues and dance studios purchase a SOCAN license which gives them permission to use copyrighted materials without having to pay a fee for each individual use.
