

SCHEDULE ANNOUNCED FOR 2026 MONSTER ENERGY PRO DOWNHILL SERIES presented by Continental

December 23rd, 2025 (USA) – The 2026 Monster Energy Pro Downhill Series schedule was announced today. The Official US National Mountain Bike Championship series will consist of five races in 2026, including the Fox US OPEN of Mountain Biking and the USA Cycling Gravity National Championship in Big Bear Lake, CA. The series features an international field of pro and amateur athletes competing for overall championship titles.

"We saw huge growth in our audience this past year, as the level of racing continued to elevate across the Monster Energy Pro Downhill Series. We love our fast growing fanbase and one of our primary goals for 2026 is to deliver more entertainment on-site and through our racing content. We're also really excited to return to Utah after an unbelievable turnout for our inaugural event at Solitude in 2025. Entering its third season, the Pro Downhill Series will begin the year at Ride Rock Creek in North Carolina. For Round #2, the action heads to Mountain Creek Bike Park in New Jersey, one of the longest standing national race venues in the country. Round #3 will bring the series West, for the highly anticipated return to Solitude Mountain Resort, with its electric crowds and fast racing action. Snow Summit in Big Bear Lake, CA is next on the schedule for Round #4 of the Pro Downhill Series and the USA Cycling National Championship race for both Downhill and Dual Slalom. The Series Finale Round #5 will have all eyes looking to the Fox US Open of Mountain Biking - with full event details to be announced soon.
