## FOALING EMERGENCY WHAT WE DO?



### ASSISTED VAGINAL DELIVERY

Sometimes mares require assistance with foaling due to a number of reasons. Our experienced staff are able to step in and assist your mare if difficulty arises giving birth ensuring the best chance is given for the care and survival of your mare and foal.

### CONTROLLED HOISTED DELIVERY



If a controlled hoisted delivery is required we are equipped to assist with our electric hoist installation to give your mare the best chance of a vaginal delivery.



### EMERGENCY OR ELECTIVE CAESAREAN

With our fully equipped surgical facility and on call staff, we are able to provide emergency (or less common elective) caesarean sections when required if your mare or foal is compromised.

## HIGH RISK FOALING DOWN SERVICE

High risk pregnancies include mares that have a condition or multiple conditions that threaten the safe arrival of your foal or health of your mare. We are able to accommodate a limited number of mares who may require immediate care. We have these mares under constant video surveillance along with being fitted with foaling alarms and a veterinarian on site.

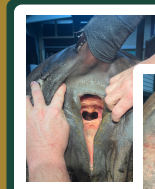

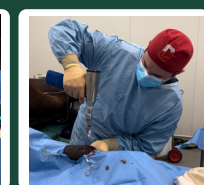
- Paddock (hard feed + hay) \$30.00 per day (mare & foal \$40.00)

- Stable & yard (hard feed + hay) \$140.00 per day (mare and foal \$150.00)



## POST FOALING SURGERY

Unfortunately some mares experience post foaling complications that require surgical intervention. This may include things such as large colon torsions and uterine tears requiring exploratory laparotomy, hernia and perineum tear repairs. Our resident Specialist Equine Surgeon is able to perform all surgeries whether it critical care or elective in our fully equipped equine surgical facility. With our on call staff available for emergencies all hours, seven days a week.

## FOAL SURGERY



Some foals may be born with angular limb deformities, flexor and extensor abnormalities that may require periosteal stripping, transphyseal bridging, limb casts or splints as well as other surgical needs such as umbilical hernias or bladder ruptures that can all be performed by our resident Specialist Equine Surgeon.
