GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Grand Session Registration will be from 1:00 - 2:30 9m on Wednesday, June 12, 2019 and will continue throughout the session. Please refer to the schedule printed in session book for all activities and locations. Have one adult pick up the packets for your Bethel and confirm the contents of the packet before leaving the registration area.

Grand Bethel Registration will be held from 8:00 – 10:00 am and from 8:00 - 9:00 pm on Thursday, June 13 for all Daughters. Guardians be sure all Daughters get registered, so the Grand Bethel Meeting can start on time Friday morning. Daughters must be registered BEFORE competing in any competitions.

Chaperones: All Daughters to age 20 must be chaperoned. Remember 1 adult for every 5 daughters.

PICTURES

REFUNDS

Refunds will be allowed only until June 1, 2019. Refund checks will be issued AFTER the Grand Session.

SESSION FEES

There will be a \$40.00 session fee for every adult and daughter attending Grand Session. The money goes to the session committee to help pay session expenses. Of these fees, per WY By-Laws GGC 3d, \$13 per person goes to Grand Council, \$500 will go to the Supreme Messenger team to help with their expense associated with their trip to Supreme, and \$1.00 will help defray the costs of the Session books. Also, \$500 will be set aside for the Miss Wyoming Job's Daughters Pageant and \$250 for the Jr Miss Pageant.

ADULT REGISTRATION

At the time of your Grand Session Registration, all adults must register as either a voting or non-voting delegate. Voting delegates are the Executive Bethel Guardian Council, Past Bethel Guardians, Past Associate Bethel Guardians, Past Grand Guardians and Past Associate Grand Guardians who are current on their dues. Dues may be paid at registration. Voting credentials will be picked up at the registration table.

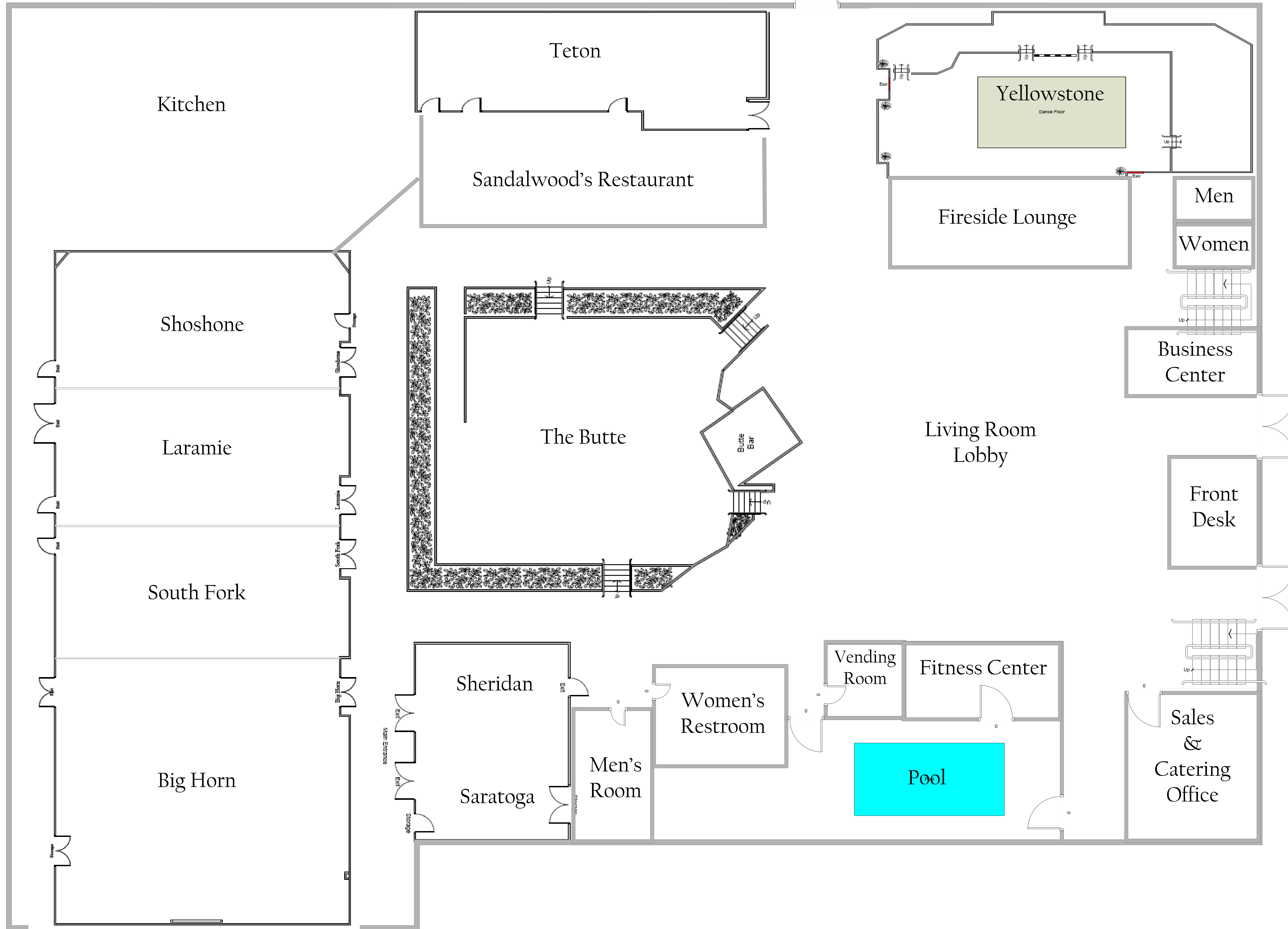

GRAND BETHEL SENIOR PRINCESS—LETTER OF INTENT

Daughters,

Any Daughter wishing to be eligible for the position of Grand Bethel Senior Princess must submit a letter of intent, signed by a parent or legal guardian, stating that the Daughter and parents and/or legal guardian understand the duties and requirements of the office of Grand Bethel Senior Princess. As you know, the Grand Bethel Senior Princess automatically advances to Grand Bethel Honored Queen in her absence. The Grand Bethel Senior Princess shall be chosen in a drawing at the annual Grand Bethel meeting from the names of the Daughters that have submitted their letter of intent.

Those eligible for the office of Grand Bethel Senior Princess are:

- Honored Queens
- All unmarried PHQ's min 15 – max 18 years of age at the time of the drawing for Grand Bethel Senior Princess (adopted 06-13)
- Submitted letter of intent signed by parent or legal guardian. This should include that you are willing to commit for 2 years, you will travel, attend all grand bethel meetings except in case of an emergency. It should also state your parents are aware of the commitment and are willing to support you in that commitment. It should list a commitment to all duties listed below.
- Must have a letter of recommendation from one (1) member of her Executive Bethel Guardian Council
- All Candidates are required to take a Ritual/Bylaws/Rules and Regulations Test at the Annual Grand Session and score a minimum of 75%
- All documentation must be submitted to the Grand Bethel Board of Trustees by May 1.

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE CONSIDERED!!!!!!

If you are committed enough to want to be Grand Bethel Honored Queen you should be committed enough to get your entry in on time!!

Duties to include:

- Submit a written report of the previous year's activities to the Grand Bethel during the Annual Grand Bethel meeting.
- Grand Bethel Honored Queen will have a fund raiser to benefit Grand Bethel.
- Grand Bethel Senior Princess shall have a fund raiser to support her attending State and International functions during her year as GBHQ.
- Grand Bethel Honored Queen can only be reimbursed for her expenses up to the net amount of her Grand Bethel Senior Princess project.
- To be reimbursed, she will keep actual receipts of her expenses and turn them over to Grand Bethel.
- To attend the Annual Grand Bethel meeting and where possible, to attend all other Grand Bethel meetings.
- To assist in all ceremonies as requested by the Grand Guardian.
- To attend Trustee meetings when and where possible.
- To travel to state activities when and where possible.

If for some reason the office of Grand Bethel Senior Princess is vacated, a replacement officer will be drawn by the Grand Bethel Trustees from the Daughters that submitted a letter of intent at the previous annual Grand Bethel meeting.

This is a big responsibility and a 2 year commitment. Please consider these responsibilities carefully and discuss them with your parents before submitting your letter.

Dear Wyoming Job's Daughters and Councils;

It is time to select your Bethel's Candidate(s) for our Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter pageant to be held at Grand Session in Cheyenne June 12-15, 2019.

Please make your choice(s) wisely and with thoughtful consideration. Your contestant(s) will be required to take a written test over the ritual and Bylaws (both Wyoming and Supreme), recite a Messenger's Initiation part, have their robe judged, have a personal interview with a panel of judges, and a stage appearance on Friday night. This is not a beauty pageant. Judging will be done in each area of participation, plus personal appearance, poise, personality, manners and sincerity.

The rules state:

(a) A Daughter must be a member in good standing in her Bethel and be at least sixteen (16) years of age at the time of the Wyoming Pageant but less than twenty (20) years of age at the time she is selected for the duties of Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter.

(b) A Daughter will be eligible to compete in no more than two (2) Pageants for the title of Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter. If a Daughter wins the title of Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter or Miss Wyoming Congeniality she may not compete in a second pageant.

(c) No more than two (2) Daughters from each Bethel may compete in the same pageant for the title of Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter.

Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter **2019-20** will be competing in the Miss International Job's Daughter Pageant **August 2019 in Overland Park, Kansas**. This leaves a very short time from our Pageant for our new Miss Wyoming to prepare, so we will attempt to follow regulations of the International Pageant to make our contestant better prepared.

Please have your Miss Wyoming candidate(s) fill out the entry form and return it to me no later than **May 1, 2019**. Any entries postmarked after **May 1, 2019** will cause your candidate(s) to have points REMOVED from their total score and hamper their success in the pageant. This deadline is set so that your candidate has plenty of time to prepare.

Contestants, please remember this deadline is your responsibility and as soon as you are selected, fill out the Entry Form and return it to me. When I receive your entry form you will get a letter from me telling you which Messenger parts to prepare and all other important information. GOOD LUCK!

Miss Competitors will be allowed to participate - every effort will be made to accommodate them. Electronic forms are available for registration upon request.

1. Ritual Competition this year will be held on **Thursday, June 13, 2019 beginning at 8:00 am.** **Daughters will receive instructions and schedules when they check in.** Daughters will be assigned a specific competition time in order to avoid waiting around by judges. Competition will be completed by **11:30 am.** Please be prompt so that everyone feels prepared to do their best!
2. All daughters will check in as they arrive, and get their schedule for their competitions. **The written test will be done together promptly at 8:15 am after everyone has been checked in.** Robe judging will follow the written test and oral competitions. Councils, please help your Daughters prepare for their oral recitation, robe judging, and written test.
3. All Wyoming Job's Daughters who have not reached the age of twenty (20) by **June 1, 2019** are eligible to enter Ritual Competition **INCLUDING** Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter contestants and Junior Miss Wyoming Job's Daughter contestants, ritual competition will be as flexible as possible for Miss Competitors.
4. Each Bethel may enter **TWO** messenger teams of five **different** Daughters to give the messenger parts, in succession, one at a time. There will be two age groups in this category; a Bethel may enter **ONE** team per age group. The oldest member on the team determines the age group. In addition, a Bethel may enter only **TWO** royalty teams. As each Daughter is limited to **ONE** team event, the royalty and messenger teams entered must be comprised of **different** Daughters. All teams will be competing against the other teams – regardless of ages.
5. Those Daughters taking part in the Story of Job competition will recite each messenger part in succession, like a story, eliminating the floor work and instructions to the Guide and Marshal.
6. Each daughter will be limited to **four** individual categories and **one** team category.
7. Robe judging is **REQUIRED** for all Daughters. Please help the Daughters get their robes ready.

WRITTEN TEST

The written test will be **REQUIRED** of all contestants. The test is based on the Ritual and **only the novice may use the ritual for the test**. General and Purple levels will not be allowed to use the ritual during the test. There will be a separate test for novice, general, and purple divisions. **All Daughters will take the ritual test together at 8:15 am** before proceeding to robe judging and oral recitation.

AWARDS

Awards will be determined on the basis of quality of performance regardless of the number of contestants entered in a particular category. **Each Daughter must reach a minimum score in order to place first, second, or third. The minimum score to receive each placing is predetermined. This means that even if a daughter is the only entrant in her category, she is not assured of a first, second, or third place award.**

The Ritualist of the Year Awards includes several judged categories as explained on the form, and the winner will receive a \$100 award, and a certificate. This competition has a separate entry form for participants. Divisions, Age Groups, Categories, Competition Parts, Official Regalia, and Written Test are explained on the enclosed pages.

2. All performers must be wearing appropriate dress/costume/outfit.
3. A time limit of 8 minutes will be enforced. If a performance exceeds the time limit, the Daughter will be disqualified.
4. A CD/tape player will be available. No lead vocals will be allowed on an accompaniment CD or tape or the Daughter will be disqualified.
5. Should you need an accompanist you will be responsible for supplying your own. If you cannot find an accompanist, contact Sheila Cooper and she will help you. DO NOT show up for the day of the competition and say you need an accompanist.
6. Each Daughter may participate in as many categories as she chooses.
7. Deadline for Registration is May 1, 2019.

Daughters submitting entries must be in good standing with JDI as of May 1, 2019 and entries must have been entirely made by the Daughter submitting the registration between the time period July 2018 and June 2019, the Grand Guardian Council year.

All registration must be **POSTMARKED OR EMAILED BY MAY 1, 2019.**

All entries must be delivered to the Sewing Committee in the room listed in the program Wednesday from 1-2:30 PM. Judging will be held Thursday afternoon of Grand Session. **NO VIEWING WILL BE ALLOWED DURING JUDGING.** . Items will be judged on Originality, Degree of Difficulty, Neatness, Craftsmanship, Design Elements, and Finishing Touches.

Entries will be judged in three (3) age groups, as follows: 10-12 years, 13-15 years and 16-19 years. A Daughter may enter one item PER Category. The Daughter must decide the category in which her entry is to be entered. However, in fairness to all Daughters, the Sewing Committee reserves the right to adjust categories. The decisions of the judges are final.

Each Entry must be accompanied by a 4X6 TYPED CARD (preferred) or printed neatly and the card **MUST BE IN PROPER FORMAT.**

FRONT OF CARD:

Description of the item which should include: the division and category entered, the style or a title for the item, time it took to complete it, and any special information the girl wants us to know, such as why she made it or how it is to be used. Card should also indicate if done by hand or machine, whether it was done from a kit, chart, pattern, or if it is a free style original design.

BACK OF CARD:

The back of the card will have the **Daughter's name** (not on front of card), age, and Bethel number. Also include on the back a way to contact you (phone number or Chaperones information) during Grand session in case we need to speak to you in regard to your item

IMPORTANT: YOUR ENTRY WILL NOT BE JUDGED IF THE CARD ISN'T CORRECTLY DONE AND DELIVERED **WITH YOUR ITEM** TO THE JUDGING AREA.
