Amos is the program you have been waiting for. Amos allows you virtual connectivity with Christ's Church virtually, but more importantly it offers connectivity with clergy and lay to support you.

What type outreach does your church do? Can I participate in it?

At Mitcham we are very focused on outreach. Over the years we have been involved in several projects. If you are available, you are encouraged to participate based upon your desire and availability.

- Lighthouse of Michigan – Yearly Peanut Butter and Jelly Drive providing over a thousand jars annually
- Lighthouse food pantry. Monthly food donations. Our Goal for this conference year ((August-July) is two tons of food.
- First Step – This is our first year providing support via a night of food and games to those in temporary housing who have suffered domestic, and sexual abuse.
- Within Reach – A local 501c3 we support. For this year we provided 200 pairs of socks and 96 hats for the homeless in Cass Park – Detroit, MI
