Overview and Board of Trustees

The NJ Service Foundation, Inc. is a 501(c)(3), non-profit corporation that is not a program of nor endorsed by or affiliated with a district. The specific objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be to solicit, collect and otherwise raise money for charitable purposes to support projects to assist the Rotary Clubs in Districts of NJ; or to assist programs, projects, events and training; or to assist Rotary International or the Rotary International Foundation.

The corporation has a minimum of five (5) trustees. Trustees must be members of Rotary District 7475 or its successor and shall each serve for three year terms. Officers are selected from the Trustees in annual elections, except the treasurer who serves a three year term.

The Trustees value diversity and celebrate the contributions of people of all backgrounds, and will not discriminate regardless of age, ethnic origin, race, color, abilities, religion, socio-economic status, culture, sex, sexual orientation, or gender identity.
