



# SCHEDULE

## YEARS ONE AND TWO

7:00 - 8:00	Arrival and Check-In
8:00 - 8:30	Table toys / Drawing / Puzzles
8:30 - 9:00	Washing Hands / Potty / Snack
9:00 - 9:15	Morning Meeting; The children are encouraged to express how they feel that morning. A song, poem or game will be introduced and the weather will be discussed. Children are encouraged to stretch their bodies.
9:15 - 10:15	Centers; The children are encouraged to play at centers. Observations will be taken and recorded. 10 minute clean-up time limit.
10:15 - 10:30	Story Time; A book will be read to the children. Questions based on the story will be asked to gauge reading comprehension
10:30 - 11:00	Outdoor play; Monday, Wednesday and Friday the class will participate in a nature walk if weather permits. Children will be encouraged to explore nature, collect leaves, look at trees and worms with a magnifying glass, observe animals that live in trees and learn about the change of weather.
11:00 - 11:15	Wash hands / potty; Children will be encouraged to wash hands and sing a song after each bathroom use.
11:15 - 11:45	Lunch; Teachers will sit with children during lunch and encourage family style eating. Children will be encouraged to try new foods
11:45 - 12:00	Wash hands / potty; Children will be encouraged to wash hands and sing a song after each bathroom use.
12:00 - 1:15	Nap time; Children are encouraged to nap and rest their bodies. Children who do not nap can lay with a book quietly.
1:15 - 1:30	Wash hands / potty; Children will be encouraged to wash hands and sing a song after each bathroom use.
1:30 - 2:00	PM Snack; Teachers will sit with children during afternoon snack and encourage family style eating.
2:00 - 2:15	Afternoon Meeting; The children will review the day, the months, the shapes, colors, count up to five and discuss the new theme for the month. A song, poem or game will be introduced
2:15 - 3:15	Centers: the children are encouraged to play at centers. Observations will be taken and recorded. 10 minute clean-up time limit.
3:15 - 3:30	Story Time; a book will be read to the children. Questions based on the story will be asked to gauge reading comprehension.
3:30 - 4:00	Outdoor Play
4:00 - 4:15	Wash hands / Potty; Children will be encouraged to wash hands and sing a song after each bathroom use.
4:15 - 4:30	Music and Movement; Children are encouraged to dance and sing along to different styles of music. The children will be encouraged to use instruments.
4:30 - 4:45	Video clip; The children will watch an educational video clip
4:45 - 5:45	Table toys / Puzzles / Play dough / Drawing (with 10 minutes of clean-up)
5:45 - 6:00	Dismissal
