# **FUNDRAISING**



The FAU AMA chapter aims to generate \$8,180 in revenue through a variety of initiatives, including corporate sponsorships, branded apparel sales, local membership dues, restaurant giveback events, university funding, and graduation stoles.

**GOAL:** Secure \$8,000 in funding via corporate sponsorships by collaborating with a minimum of three organizations.

**STRATEGY:** With faculty assistance, we will connect & send out sponsorship packages to corporate offering tiered levels of support: Platinum, Gold, and Silver.

GOAL: Generate a total of \$2,080 by collecting local membership dues, expecting 65 members paying \$32 each in local dues.

**STRATEGY:** Regularly emphasize the advantages of becoming a paid member.

**GOAL:** Raise \$150 through branded apparel sales by selling 30 t-shirts.

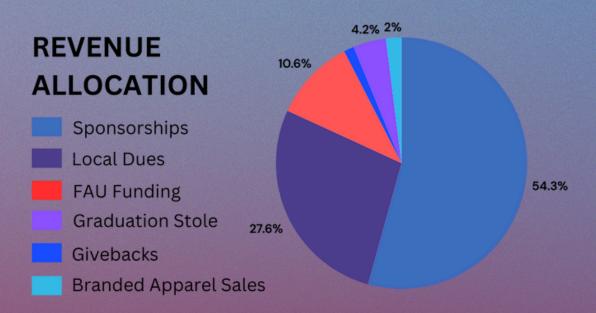
**STRATEGY:** Collaborate with an apparel company to launch an online store to provide branded merchandise.

**GOAL:** Raise \$150 through restaurant giveback events with a target of 20 participants using our promotional code.

**STRATEGY:** We will promote the event across social media, our GroupMe chat, and during meetings leading up to the event.

**GOAL:** Secure \$800 in funding from the Council of Student Organizations at FAU.

**STRATEGY:** Present our funding proposal to the Council of Student Organizations, ensuring we request an appropriate and well-justified amount
