

ORDINANCE NO. 95- 02

TOWNSHIP OF MORGAN
GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MORGAN, COUNTY
OF GREENE, PENNSYLVANIA, LAYING OUT SCHOOL
STREET WHICH IS SITUATED IN THE VILLAGE OF
MATHER AS ONE-WAY.

WHEREFORE, it is now deemed necessary for the protection
of the health, cleanliness, comfort and safety of the citizens of
the Township of Morgan to enact this Ordinance; and

WHEREFORE, the citizens of the Village of Mather have
petitioned the Supervisors of Morgan Township to change School
Street to a one-way direction (a copy of the petition is attached
as Exhibit "A").

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority conferred upon
it by the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code, the Board of
Supervisors of Morgan Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania does
hereby enact this Ordinance as aforementioned by ENACTING AND
ORDAINING the following:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known
as the "School Street Ordinance".

SECTION 2. GENERAL SCOPE. The subject matter of this
Ordinance is the regulation of the traffic flow upon School Street
from being two-way to one-way.

SECTION 3. TRAFFIC FLOW. The traffic flow shall
proceed in one direction along the length of School Street,
proceeding from Circle Street in the direction towards Third
Street.

SECTION 4. SIGNS. The Board of Supervisors shall erect signs showing the one-way direction of the traffic flow along School Street.

SECTION 5. NOTICE. The Board of Supervisors shall give notice to the property owners bounding School Street of the change in traffic flow.

SECTION 6. VIOLATIONS. Any violations of this traffic flow pattern along the length of School Street shall be enforced by the Motor Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania (see Title 75 §1 et. seq.).

SECTION 7. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance are hereby declared severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, or otherwise void for any reason, such decision shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions hereof; it is hereby declared to be the intent of the Township that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such invalid, unconstitutional, or otherwise void provisions had not been included herein.

SECTION 8. REPEALER. Any Ordinance containing any provision inconsistent herewith to the extent that such provisions are inconsistent, those provisions are also hereby repealed.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately.
