ORDINANCE NO. 2 - 1988

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS OR TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE IN MORGAN TOWNSHIP, GREENE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA; DECLARING IT TO BE A NUISANCE FOR THOSE ENGAGED IN SUCH PURSUITS TO GO IN OR UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES WITHOUT HAVING BEEN REQUESTED OR INVITED TO DO SO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES CONFLICTING HERewith.

The Board of Supervisors of Morgan Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania, hereby enacts and ordains as follows:-

SECTION 1. The practice of going in and upon private residences in Morgan Township, Greene County, Pennsylvania, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, itinerant merchants or transient vendors of merchandise for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares, and merchandise and/or disposing of and/or peddling or hawking the same unless invited to do so by the owner or owners, occupant or occupants of said private residences, is declared to be a nuisance and punishable as such.

SECTION 2. Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than \$100.00 or imprisoned not more than 30 days or both fined and imprisoned at the discretion of a Magistrate having jurisdiction thereof.

SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to the sale or solicitation of orders for the sale of milk, dairy products, vegetables, poultry, eggs and other farm and garden produce so far as now authorized by law.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this Ordinance shall not apply to non-profit corporations organized for religious, charitable or educational purposes, or any

associations organized for such purposes, or any agencies of the government of the United States or of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
