**MINUTES OF MORGAN TOWNSHIP  
July 1, 2025**

**CALL TO ORDER:** At 4:00 p.m. Jeff Sholtis, Chairman, called the regular monthly meeting of the Morgan Township Supervisors to order in the municipal office building located at 1019 Third Street Extension, Mather, Greene County, Pennsylvania. The meeting opened with the pledge to the flag.

**ROLL CALL:** Supervisors Jeff Sholtis, Erik Mullen and Shirl Barnhart were present. Also attending the meeting was George Scull, Susan Nelson, Cheryl Semonick, Cerise Policz, Diane Tedrow, John Green, David Saunders, Solicitor Dennis Makel and Secretary/Treasurer Relda Litten.

**APPROVE MINUTES:** A motion was made by Mr. Barnhart with a second from Mr. Mullen to approve the minutes of June 3, 2025 meeting and the motion carried with all in favor.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS:** Ms. Semonick was looking for updated ordinances online.

**REPORTS:** Roadmaster: The township has removed trees, mowed along roads – first cut almost finished. They have also prepared the roads for oil and chipping, worked on GMC, did some cold patching, Food Bank participation, had #8 stone delivered, installed a wedge curb on 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Mather, installed a chain link fence around the basketball court and EQT has repaired Hull Run Road

**LEGAL:** Mr. Makel has been working on agreements with EQT and would like a supervisor to attend the Schimansky hearing on July 21<sup>st</sup>.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER:** Mr. Gordon is on vacation but turned in his report for the month. He has written 10 citations, investigated one complaint and sent nine violation notices to residents.

**ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS AND LOT SPLITS:** A motion was made Mr. Mullen, seconded by Mr. Barnhart to approve the Chidester/Brink Lot Split and the motion carried with all in favor.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** The cameras for the office are tabled to next month. The Heavy Hauling Agreement is also tabled till next month.

A motion was made by Mr. Barnhart, seconded by Mr. Mullen to approve the Resolution for Plan Revision for New Land Development for Country Club Road sewer extension only. It was not approved for Chartiers Road as the township has not received any complaints nor a petition was not turned in from the residents as usually happens when residents request sewage. A letter will be sent to Lower Ten Mile explaining the decision.

**NEW BUSINESS:** A motion was made by Mr. Barnhart, seconded by Mr. Mullen to approve the quote from Citgo Water for a box culvert to be used on Browns Road and the motion carried with all in favor.
