

Job Title: Lifeguard - Community City-Owned Pool

Location: Reinbeck, IA

Job Type: Part-Time/Seasonal

Position Overview:

The Lifeguard is responsible for ensuring the safety and well-being of all visitors at the Reinbeck Aquatic Center. This role involves monitoring the pool area, enforcing safety rules, and responding to emergencies. Lifeguards are also responsible for maintaining a clean environment and providing excellent customer service to all pool guests.

Key Responsibilities:

- Monitor pool activity and ensure all safety rules and regulations are followed by guests.
- Respond to emergencies quickly and effectively, providing first aid and CPR as necessary.
- Assist with the safe entry and exit of swimmers, ensuring the pool area is properly maintained.
- Maintain a high level of vigilance to detect any unsafe situations and take appropriate actions.

- Must be able to swim proficiently and be in good physical condition.
- Must be at least 15 years old.

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to stand, sit, or walk for extended periods of time.
- Must be able to swim and perform rescues if needed.
- Ability to lift and carry objects up to 25 pounds.
- Ability to work outdoors in various weather conditions, including heat and sun exposure.
