



PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

(The following is paraphrased from Reinbeck City Ordinances.)

PERMITS (Building Permits)

No building, or structure shall be constructed, reconstructed, altered or placed in any district of the City unless a building permit signed by the Building Inspector (City Administrator) has been issued.

106 GARBAGE AND TRASH PICK-UP

Garbage and trash are picked up every Tuesday in Reinbeck (curbside ready by 7 a.m.). The garbage and trash go to the Blackhawk County Landfill. The garbage, trash, etc., must be in a biodegradable plastic bag with the City of Reinbeck logo on it and placed on the side of the curb for collection. The bags are available to purchase from Trunck's Country Foods and cost is \$7.50 for ten bags. The cost of the bags helps to pay the cost of recycling

151.03 TREE TRIMMING

Trees and tree limbs, shrubbery plus trimmings, leaves, grass clippings and garden waste can be taken to the City Yard Waste and Burn Pile on North Commercial Street to dispose of them. No lumber, boards, etc., can be disposed of at this sight. Hours: 8:00 a.m. to dusk.

69.12 WINTER PARKING

No parking on the city streets or alleys between the hours of 2:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. during the months of November, December, January, February, and March. Tickets will be issued whether snow removal is done or not.

55.14 DOGS AND CATS

Dogs and cats are not to run freely. They can be impounded by the City if they are loose. Owners will be responsible for any charges that might occur if they are impounded.

HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE

105.05.4 **BURNING AND DUMPING OF REFUSE**.

[It is unlawful] To dispose of by burning, dumping, or otherwise, any garbage, offal, tin, styrofoam, cans, or any other form of refuse within the corporate limits of the City, except dumping in a place specifically designated by the City for dumping of such refuse, or collection and removal as authorized in City Code Chapter 107. For purposes of this Section, the definitions of "refuse" and "garbage" in City Code Section 107.02 shall apply.

It shall be unlawful to commit any of the following acts:

- A. To burn any lawful items except on Monday, Thursday and Saturday between 8:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.
 - B. That all burning must be complete and fires extinguished before 6:00 p.m.
 - C. Burning must be conducted in a safe manner including use of a steel barrel, screen/mesh over the top to prevent cinders and sparks from spreading, adult supervision until flames are extinguished, safe distance from buildings and other property and to obey lawful orders/ruling regarding burning.
 - D. Open burning is permitted only on the days permitted for burn barrel burning. Open burning consists of the burning of trees and tree trimmings, bushes and bush trimmings, leaves, and garden waste. (Stem and leaves only).
 - E. Recreational Fires, open fires for cooking, heating, recreation, and ceremonies are permitted at any time. Such burning must comply with the limits for emission of visible air contaminants established by the State Department of Natural Resources. Rubber tires shall not be burned in a recreational fire.
 - F. **PENALTY:** The penalty for violation of Section 105.05.4 upon conviction will be \$10.00 first offense, \$50.00 second offense, and \$100.00 third and subsequent offenses and be subject to imprisonment not exceeding thirty (30) days.



RECYCLING

Newspapers, plastic, tin cans, glass materials can be recycled and are picked up once a month in Reinbeck. The separated materials must be placed at the curbside. The second Tuesday of the month is pick up day for residents.

The Reinbeck Recycling Center is also located at the Napa Store on Hwy 175 so recycling can be dropped off at anytime.

THINGS TO RECYCLE

- Paper and cardboard-newsprint, clear corrugated cardboard. Wrap in a bundle, put in a paper bag, or put in a cardboard box.
- Magazines, catalogs and advertising slicks.
- Cans must be washed and clean.
- Plastic. All plastic must be clean and dry. No Styrofoam, egg cartons, cups and plates, meat and fruit trays, or packing materials.

REINBECK RECYCLING CENTER

Recycling brought to the Reinbeck Recycling Center is the most efficient way to handle recycling. The Recycling Center has containers that are labeled as follows:

CARDBOARD ONLY: Dumpster and Compactor

- 1) No Styrofoam
- 2) No Plastics
- 3) No Paper

PLASTICS ONLY: Dumpster and Recycling Truck

- 1) Must have Recycling Logo 1, 2, 3, 4, or 5
- 2) No Bags
- 3) No Cardboard
- 4) No Paper

MIXED PAPER ONLY: Roll-off Container with doors on side of Container.

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, telephone books, junk mail or office paper.

- 1) No Plastic
- 2) No Cardboard
- 3) No Bags (Paper must be emptied from bags)

The Reinbeck Memorial Building (208 Broad Street) has two rooms available for renting. Kitchen facilities are available. Call City Hall for pricing and availability.


