## REINBECK PROJECT UPDATES

The new playground equipment has been installed. Thank you to all the volunteers that came out to help with the build. The Park Board continues to do fund-raisers for the new Bathhouse Project. They are selling Reinbeck Aquatic Center T-Shirts as part of their fund-raising efforts. The city has hired Snyder & Associates to perform work on a Stormwater Improvement Project on Highway 175 Crossing at Chestnut Street. Depending on the weather, we look for this project to begin sometime in the spring.

More cemetery driveway will be replaced in the spring. This has been an ongoing project for the past couple of years. We are trying to replace the worst sections first. As budget permits, we hope to continue this project.

## FITNESS CENTER RENEWAL

All Pin numbers for the Reinbeck Fitness Center will expire at the end of the year. You will need to fill out a new Fitness Center Application and submit the annual fee with your application to receive a new Pin number for 2020. Applications are available at City Hall or on the city's website <https://reinbeck.org>. Memberships run from January 1st through December 31st. The 2020 annual membership fee is \$65 for a single membership and \$95 for a family membership. A Fitness Center Membership is also another great Christmas Gift!

## MEMORIAL BUILDING RENT

The American Legion has increased the fee to rent the Legion Room at the Memorial Building. The fee to rent the Legion Room with the bar is \$150 and the fee to rent the Legion Room without the use of the bar is \$200. The Auditorium rent is the same as it has been at \$100. There is still a deposit on both rooms. The deposit is the amount of the rental and is due at the time of booking. The rent is due when you pick up the key. Your deposit will be returned to you upon a satisfactory inspection of the room rented. Any damages or an unclean facility will result in holding a portion or all of your deposit. Your help in keeping this facility a wonderful place for everyone to utilize is greatly appreciated.

## CITY ORDINANCES TO REMEMBER

So that the streets can be plowed, no person shall park, abandon or leave unattended any vehicle on any public street, alley or City-owned off-street parking area between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. during the months of November, December, January, February and March. It is the responsibility of the abutting property owners to remove snow, ice, and accumulations promptly from sidewalks. It is unlawful for any person to throw, push, or place any ice or snow from private property, sidewalks, or driveways onto the street. You will be charged if the city must go back and clean up in front of your property due to pushing snow in the street after plows have cleared the street. You can view the entire City of Reinbeck Ordinances at City Hall. Thank you for your cooperation in allowing the city streets and alleys to get cleared in a timely manner and for keeping the sidewalks clear. Also, be courteous to your neighbors and do not blow your snow onto their property.
