MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL BUDGET HEARING MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR REINBECK, IOWA
HELD IN COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT 5:00 P.M.

(These are the minutes to be approved by the council at the next city council meeting)

Mayor Eiffler called the meeting to order at 5:01 p.m. Council present at roll call were Wambold, Pease, Johnson, and Bueghly. Trepp was absent. Also present was Wilkerson.

Wambold moved to approve the Consent Agenda, seconded by Johnson. 4 ayes. Motion carried. The approved Consent Agenda consisted of Minutes from April 20, 2026 Special Budget Hearing Meeting and Bills to be paid in the amount of \$39,397.22.

Mayor Eiffler opened the FY2027 Budget Hearing at 5:01 p.m. The FY27 budget was discussed and the Levy Rate will be \$12.10245. No other comments were received. Johnson moved to close the hearing, seconded by Wambold. 4 ayes. Motion carried. The hearing was closed at 5:32 p.m.

Hearing no comments, for or against, written or oral, Bueghly moved to approve Resolution #2026-12R, A Resolution Adopting FY2027 Budget and Certification of City Taxes and have the clerk file it with the State and County Auditor, seconded by Pease. Roll call vote: Wambold – aye, Pease – aye, Johnson – aye, Bueghly – aye. Motion carried.

Mayor informed the council, because this is an even year, the CIP Levy can't be on the November ballot but the city can have a Special Election in September for this Levy vote. Johnson moved to have the city hold a Special Election in September for the CIP Levy vote, seconded by Bueghly. 4 ayes. Motion carried.

Updates and concerns from council: the attorney is moving forward with getting possession of 506 Broad. Wilkerson will have the city guys remove any damaged benches from Main Street. Bueghly would like to see School Street between Broad & Center be parking on one side only. This will be put on the next Agenda. Pease asked if dips on Valley Drive could be fixed. Wilkerson will check to see if The Pavement Doctor can come back in town and do some more repairs. Bueghly and Wambold gave an update on RAGBRAI.

Having no further business to discuss, Bueghly moved to adjourn, seconded by Wambold. 4 ayes. Motion carried. The meeting was adjourned at 5:20 p.m.
