

Step 2 The Future College Tour ~ March 30 – April 3, 2026

Student Code of Conduct

- Students must follow instructions given by the tour chaperones and are expected to communicate in a respectful manner during the tour.
- Headphones are required when enjoying music, or movies on electronic devices.
- Students will not be permitted to be alone at any time during the tour, and they must have express permission from tour chaperones before leaving the group at any time.
- Each student is responsible for maintaining their personal belongings and the common area on the bus and in the lodging location in an orderly fashion.
- Tour participants have a responsibility to maintain a high degree of cleanliness/hygiene.
- Casual wear must be appropriate. No bare midriff showing, no short shorts or skirts, wording on clothes must be appropriate, no baggy pants worn below the waistline (wear belts when necessary), no undergarments shall show, no back-out or low-cut tops. Each student will be expected to be fully and properly dressed and wear appropriate clothing to participate in touring activities. Jewelry and any other expensive items are worn and/or carried on the tour at your own risk.
- Students will be responsible for paying for any damage done to the bus, the lodging, and/or touring areas. Students will alert the chaperones immediately if a problem exists.

The following behaviors are Strictly Prohibited:

- Profanity, smoking, excessive noise or loud talking, leaving the group without permission, possession of weapon(s), illegal drugs, or alcohol, harmful tricks and/or games played on others, bullying or any other negative behaviors towards others, and sexual conduct or acts committed. Unruly and disorderly conduct is prohibited.

If a touring student is arrested for drug possession, use, buy, or any other crime, they can expect to remain in the custody of the arresting officials until a parent/guardian arrives on location (at their expense), to make or see to necessary arrangements for release. A phone call will be made by the chaperones to inform the parents/guardians of the location. No chaperone or any member of the group will stay with the touring student. **The tour will continue.**
