RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACTION PRESIDENT TRUMP SHOULD TAKE REGARDING THE STATE
OF THE UNION ADDRESS

WHEREAS, Speaker of the House of Representatives Nancy Pelosi is refusing to provide the House of Representatives Chamber in our Nation's Capital as a venue for President Trump's State of the Union Address,

WHEREAS: Speaker Pelosi is refusing to negotiate in good faith with the President to resolve extraordinary immigration and security issues occurring on the Southern Border of the United States,

WHEREAS: Speaker Pelosi is using unfounded reasons to delay The State of the Union Address such as personal security for the Members of Congress and the partial Government Shutdown,

WHEREAS: Speaker Pelosi, based on her political objective of not addressing these very important issues, is overturning long traditions to prevent the President from using the House Chamber venue to convey important information to Congress and the American people,

WHEREAS: Article II, Section 3 of the Constitution of the United States of America concerning the Executive Power vested in the President of the United States of America reads in part

"He shall from time to time give to Congress Information of the State of the Union, and recommend to their Consideration such Measures as he shall judge necessary and expedient; he may, on extraordinary Occasions, convene both Houses, or either of them, and in the Case of Disagreement between them, with Respect to the time of Adjournment, he may adjourn then to such time as he shall think proper, -----"

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Beaufort County South Carolina Republican Party believes Speaker Pelosi and the Democrat Party have created an extraordinary Occasion and strongly support and encourage President Trump to use his enumerated powers under Article II, Section 3 to convene both house of Congress in order to give a State of the Union address on January 29, 2019 in the House of Representatives Chamber which has been traditionally suitable for such occasions.
