

A Resolution of

Hilton Head Island Precinct 6, Beaufort County, South Carolina Republican Party

Regarding

United States Civil Service Personnel Policy Reform

Whereas: The United States Department of Veterans Affairs has made great improvements in their efficiency and service over the last two years.

Whereas: Most of these improvements in efficiency came from changes granted to the Secretary for Veterans Affairs to remove underperforming government employees.

Whereas: We have seen in recent years instances of other government employees abusing their positions for further political or professional gain in other agencies.

Whereas: Continued abuse of position in civil service by government workers for political or personal advantage cannot be tolerated.

Whereas: The United States taxpayers deserve the most efficient and cost-effective government possible.

Whereas: The bureaucratic hurdles remain in place at most federal agencies to remove underperforming government employees.

THEREFORE: The members of Hilton Head Island Republican Precinct Six recommend to the South Carolina Republican Party that legislation be initiated and subsequently passed to enable all secretaries of cabinet agencies to be granted the personnel policies and procedures granted to the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.
