HISTORY, PURPOSE & OBJECTIVES

The California Black Campers of Southern California (CBCSC) is a nonprofit association committed to promoting fellowship, friendship, and recreational engagement. Guided by principles that are non-sectarian, non-partisan, non-sectional, and non-racial, the organization remains steadfast in its dedication to bringing people together through shared experiences.

In 1998, the Trail Masters RV Club made history as the first Southern California group to attend the California Black Campers Association (CBCA) Jamboree. Their participation led to the designation of the "Southern California Branch of the CBCA." Recognizing the growing interest and community spirit, the CBCSC was officially formed in 2000 under the General Nonprofit Association Law of the State of California. The organization operates with no intention of pecuniary gain or profit to its members.

To ensure ongoing collaboration and tradition, the CBCA and CBCSC established an alternating schedule for hosting the annual September Jamboree. The CBCA previously hosted in even-numbered years in Northern California, while CBCSC hosts in odd-numbered years in Southern California.

The Jamboree serves as a vital fundraising event, primarily aimed at supporting scholarships for high school seniors pursuing higher education. Two scholarships were established to honor visionary leaders: CBCSC Founder S. J. McGee and Van Nuys Traveliers President Pamela Hodges.

As CBCSC celebrates its 25th Anniversary, we proudly honor all those who have played a vital role in shaping the organization's growth and success through their many years of dedicated service as CBCSC representatives.
