Government regulations require each dog to undertake a health and behavioural assessment to ensure the well-being of each dog when in a service provided by SPW.

a. Behavioural assessment comprises of

- * dog handler to complete questionnaire in section 3 of this 'Service Agreement'
- * the dog & their handler (owners) to attend a 15-minute assessment of the dogs behaviour held at SPW, NSW Chippendale office before a service is delivered to your dog by SPW

b. Vet Health Check

- * Vet to complete PART A of **PDF-Vet / Health Check Form** which can be found on SPW website page titled 'Agreements & Forms'
- * Vet to lodge complete form through SPW website page 'Agreement & Forms' and lodge under section titled 'Agreement & Form Lodgement Below'
- * Vet to clarify the following are up-to-date
 - a. yearly vaccination
 - b. Pyraquantel worming
 - c. SR12 Heart worming injection or
 - d. dog handler states their dog receives a tick, flea & worming treatment either monthly or 3-monthly tablet

Government required health & behavioural assessment of assistance dog

Under the Queensland Guide, Hearing, and Assistance dog ACT 2009 (hereafter) an assistance dog is required to undertake a VET Health Check ensuring the health of the dog when working in Australian public areas, this forms part of the Queensland Public Access Test (PAT) requirements for the dog to gain access into Australian Public Areas.

- a. Behavioural assessment comprises of
- * dog handler to complete Part A. of 'Service Agreement'
- * assistance dog & their handler (owner) will hold either a 'video conference call' attend a 15minute assessment at SPW, NSW Chippendale Office assessing the relationship between assistance dog & their handler

b. Vet Health Check

- * Vet to complete PART A & B of PDF-Vet / Health Check Form which can be found on SPW website page 'Agreements & Forms'
- * Vet to lodge completed **PDF-VET** through SPW website page 'Agreement & Forms' and lodge through section titled 'Agreement & Form Lodgement Below'
- c. Dog Handlers Declaration
- dog handler states their dog receives a tick, flea & worming treatment either monthly or
 3-monthly

Government required medical practitioners health assessment of the dog handler Under Queensland Guide, Hearing, and Assistance Dog Act 2009 (hereafter) the dog handler must have a medical condition in which an assistance dog would alleviate symptoms and only a medical practitioner can approve the dog handler to have an assistance dog. The medical health check is part of Queensland Public Access Test (PAT) requirements for the dog handler & their assistance dog to gain access into Australian public areas.

a. Medical Health Check

If **The Team** demonstrated a good understanding of the health and behavioural standard requirements to gain access into Australian public areas in their upload Mini-Queensland PAT video assessment tasks. SPW will issue the dog handler with an 'in-training' Australian Public Access Photo ID Card for 4-months, + SPW badging to be displayed on either side of the assistance dogs harness when working in Australian public areas.

If The Team demonstrates perfect health and behavioural standard requirements to gain access into Australian public areas in their upload PAT video assessment tasks. SPW will issue the dog handler with an 'full' Australian Public Access Photo ID Card for 12-months.

Cost: Break Down

- 1.5-2 hours assessment of dog handlers uploaded Queensland PAT video assessment tasks,
 - + complete Qld PAT assessment Form,
 - + storage of videos \$240
- Assessment of assistive tasks \$75 Australian Public Access Photo ID Card \$25

Section 6. Assistance Dog Accreditation Program Subsidy Support

If a dog handler only source income is a government paid benefit the dog handler can the apply to receive a 50% subsidy off all costs, this excludes NDIS clients or NDIS application pending.

The dog handler to supply the following information for assessing subsidy qualification:

- latest Centrelink Income Statement
- copy of bank statement showing last 3-months your government benefit was deposited

Declaration

The dog handler declares they are not a client of NDIS &/or not applied for NDIS in the last 12-

Please note: if the dog handler has given false testimony and is a NDIS client &/or applied for NDIS within the last 12-months (application pending) SPW will issue an invoice to the dog handler for total subsidy amount

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
