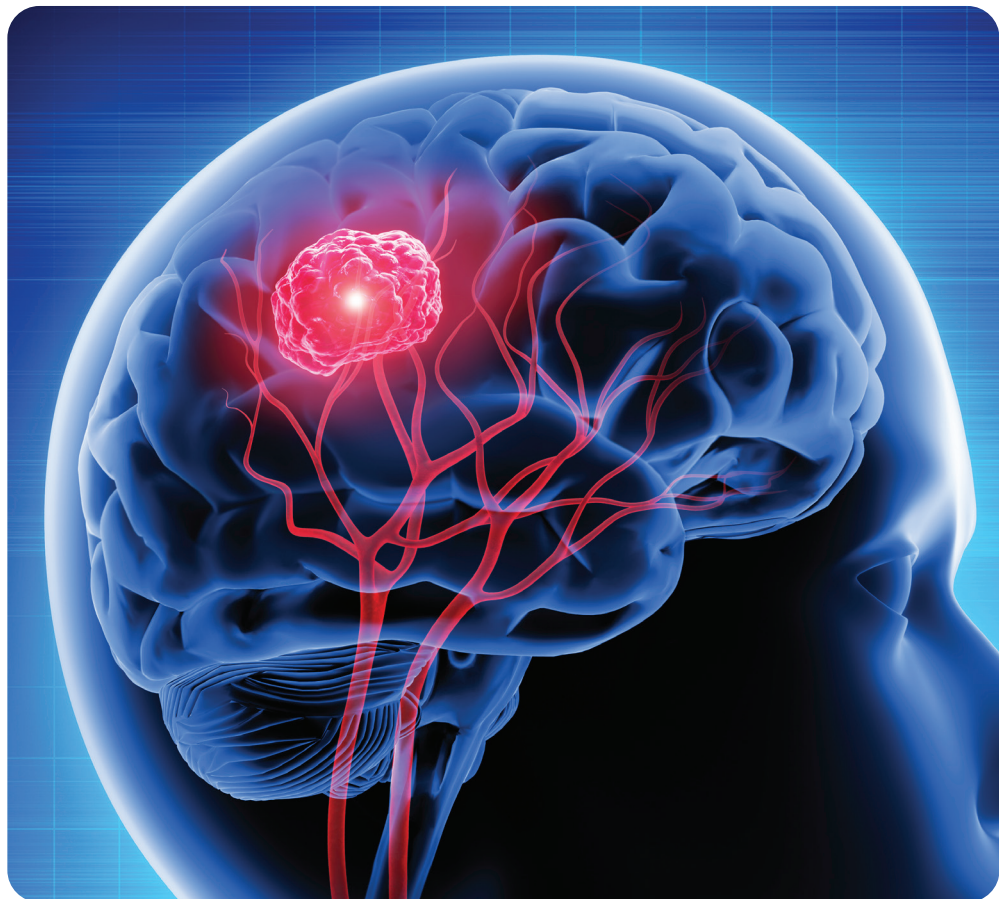

Meningioma is the most common benign cerebral tumor and often grows outside the brain without symptoms—making referral timing important and careful monitoring essential. Referral is appropriate when progression or neurologic impact is suspected, including:

- **Incidental meningioma greater than 1 cm**—or any lesion with interval growth
- **Seizure or transient neurologic event**—focal seizures, aphasia, altered awareness
- **New focal deficit or cognitive change**—weakness, sensory loss, gait imbalance, cognitive decline
- **Visual change**—field deficit, diplopia, blurred vision; concern for optic nerve compression
- **Speech or language change**—word-finding difficulty; expressive and receptive deficits
- **Headache red flags**—progressive, morning-predominant, pressure-like, or worsens with coughing, bending, or straining

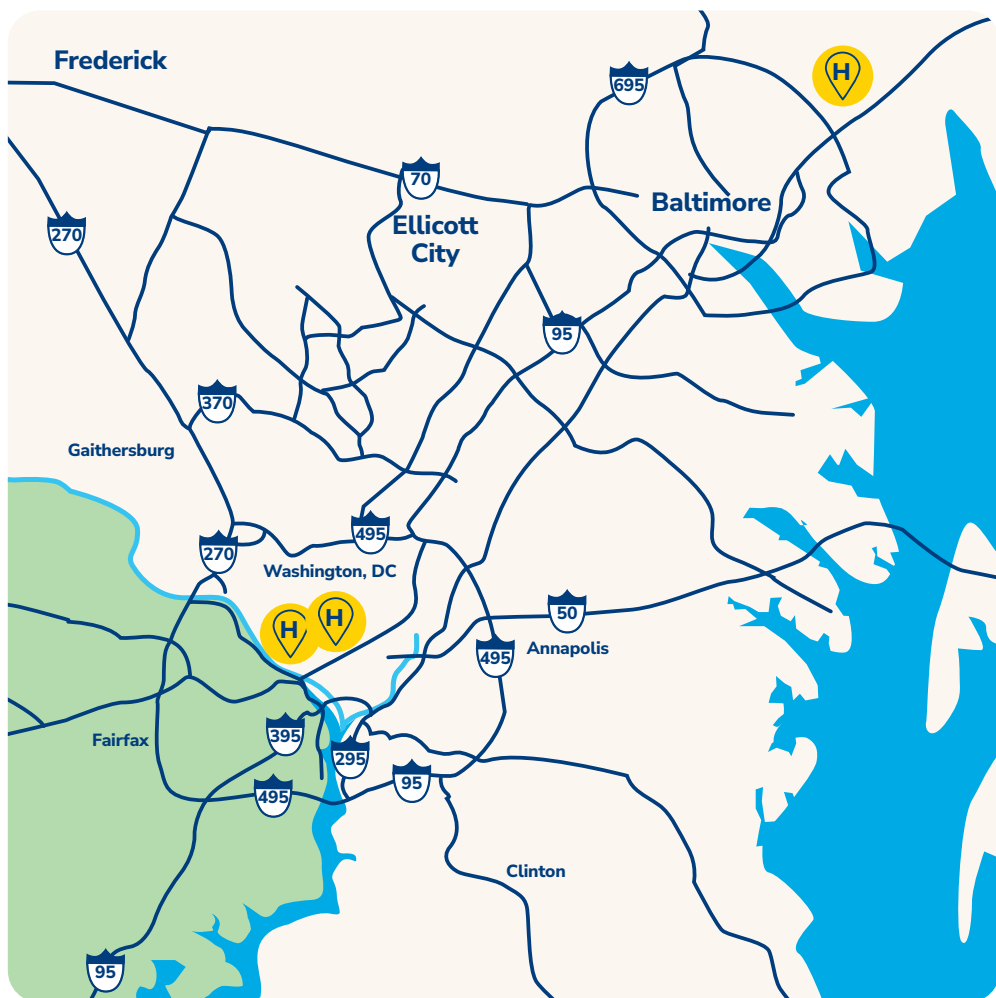
