DEPART THE UNITED STATES

Day1 Depart your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic. Enjoy in-flight entertainment And meal service as you travel to start your vacation.

MILAN ARRIVAL

Day2 After landing at Milan Airport, complete customs and immigration formalities. Your tour director will welcome you to Italy and escort you and your luggage to the coach. Next, set off on a guided orientation tour to see the highlights of the chic northern capital of Milan. Along the way, view Duomo di Milano, the second-largest cathedral in the world. Then, view the nearby La Scala, one of the most famous opera houses in the world. The theatre first opened in 1778 and was called Nuovo Regio Ducal Teatro alla Scala. Following, enjoy some free time to have lunch and explore on your own. Continue your journey into Stresa, check into your hotel and settle into your room. In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a delightful welcome dinner in the hotel restaurant. (D)

LAKE COMO SIGHTSEEING

Day3 Today, journey into Como, which has been a popular holiday destination for artists, poets and politicians alike. Upon arrival, set off on a walking tour with a local guide to see the principal sites of the charming city center, which overlooks the stunning glistening blue waters of Lake Como. This beautiful town has kept much of its ancient Roman street plans, beginning in the lovely Piazza cavour. After, embark on a boat ride to Bellagio to enjoy some free time to explore around the beautiful town with its past buildings, vibrant flowers and quaint cobbled streets. Walk along the lakeside and narrow alleyways lined with craft shops, boutiques and cafes. You might also like to visit Giardini di Villa Melzi or take photos at La Punta Spartivento. Or perhaps, you may like to visit Basilica di San Giacomo or Chiesa San Giacomo. After, take in stunning panoramic views as you travel through charming landscapes and picturesque villages back into Stresa. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure to explore and dine as you wish. OVERNIGHT: HOTEL LA PALMA, STRESA (B)

BORROMEAN ISLES

Day4 This morning, set off on a boat ride to Isola Bella, one of the handful of tiny isles located just off the shores of Stresa, known as the Borromean Isles. Upon arrival, stop to visit the 17th-century Palazzo Borromeo (Royal Palace), which takes up most of the island with its elaborate terraced gardens. Admire impressive fine art and decor within the sumptuous palace and meander through the gardens, enjoying views of Lake Maggiore and the surrounding mountains. After, take a cruise to Isola dei Pescatori and stop to enjoy some free time to explore the island with its narrow alleyways and romantic churches. Following, head to a nearby venue to experience a special "Be My Guest" dinner (not guaranteed, subject to availability), where you will have the opportunity to try local specialties and see incredible views of Lake Maggiore. Return to your hotel in Stresa for a free evening. OVERNIGHT: HOTEL LA PALMA, STRESA. (B & D)

STRESA TO SIENA

Day5 Leaving Stresa, travel into the historic foodie city of **Bologna** and stop to enjoy some free time to grab an independent bite to eat and explore on your own. You might like to visit the beautiful Piazza Maggiore. No square in Italy is more animated and endlessly fascinating than this piazza. Continue your journey through Tuscany's low-lying hills and olive groves to Siena, one of Italy's most beautiful cities. Upon arrival, check into your Hotel and enjoy some free time to relax or freshen up before tonight's farewell festivities. This evening, head to a local venue to experience a special cooking class, where you will learn hands on how to make homemade Pasta/Ravioli and Cantucci Biscotti, gems of Italy cuisine. The outcome of your culinary experience will be your dinner tonight. OVERNIGHT: HOTEL - NH, SIENA (B & D)

Day6 After breakfast, embark on a lovely walking tour through Siena's narrow, gothic streets to see stunning palaces, mansions and the historic Piazza Del Campo, where the famous Palio Horse Race is held twice a year. Also, stop to view Siena's Duomo, a beautiful mixture of Romanesque-Gothic architecture designed by Nicola Pisano. Siena's Duomo would have been the largest cathedral in the Christian world had plans not been abandoned due to the plague of 1348. Following, transfer to Civitavecchia Port, where all Land Tour services come to an end. Get ready to enjoy a 7-night fabulous Mediterranean Cruise! (B,L&D)
