Marchesi del Salento produces a range of superb quality wines from the deep south of Italy, in the 'heel' of the italian peninsula, an area well known for its rich, fruity and full bodied wines.

The winery is located in the heart of the 'Salento' production area (south Apulia), on 250 hectares (600 acres) of rich land with an ancient wine-making tradition.

Thanks to its very favorable climatic conditions, the south of Italy can offer wines that are crafted in an International style, soft, juicy, round, and well structured but with unique taste.

The Cellar, located very close the vineyards, is equipped with the latest machinery, enabling to produce very clean, fresh and modern wines. The barriques, used for "II Gladiatore" wine, are stored in the underground historical cellar, for perfect aging conditions.



MARCHESI DEL SALENTO enhances the elegance of its wines by producing its labels on high-quality paper with gold metallic foil, fine embossing and attractively placing the labels high on its sophisticated bottles.
