

#### **OUR LEADERS**

*Gregory Paul Shook, Artistic and Musical Director*, is a native of Hagerstown, Maryland, where he received his early musical training. In 1993, he and Ned Wetherald co-founded Hagerstown Choral Arts, now in its 31<sup>st</sup> season. Greg is Minister of Music Emeritus from Trinity Lutheran Church in Hagerstown and serves as adjunct faculty at Shepherd University, Barbara Ingram School for the Arts, and Hagerstown Community College.

In his previous life as a free-lance oboist, Greg performed with the Harrisburg Symphony, York Symphony, Washington National Symphony, and six seasons with the Washington Bach Consort. He is often called upon as clinician and adjudicator for choral and instrumental programs in the Tri-State area.

Greg is an alumni of Shepherd University and holds graduate degrees and certifications from the University of Maryland at College Park, United Theological Seminary, and a Master of Church Music from Shenandoah Conservatory.

*Mary Remsburg, Accompanist and Rehearsal Assistant*, was raised in the small town of Franklin, West Virginia, and graduated from Shepherd University in 2016 with a Music Education degree.

She was part of the Shenandoah Valley Children's Choir for 9 years growing up, which gave her the opportunity to be selected to perform at numerous venues, including Carnegie Hall and The White House.

During her time at Shepherd University, Mary was part of the Jazz Combo and Jazz Ensemble, which gave her the honor of performing with Award Winning composer Maria Schneider. Mary also performed at several Honors Recitals at the Washington County Museum of Fine Arts, both as a classical soloist and in the Jazz Combo. She accompanied for Women's Camerata for several years, as well as Performance Forums and senior recitals.

Mary currently teaches through her private studio at Shepherd University, teaches at Saint James School, and is the accompanist for Hagerstown Choral Arts. Mary also frequently plays for musical productions, recitals, recordings, private events, and concerts.

Aside from the classical and jazz world, Mary recently released her very first folk album entitled, "Sounds Like Home," under the stage name "Mister Mae," and music has been featured on multiple radio programs both in the United States and the United Kingdom. She is married to Chase Remsburg, another graduate of Shepherd University."

#### PROGRAM NOTES

Born in 1945, English composer John Rutter has become a regular on choral programs worldwide. While not a religious man, his compositions deeply reflect his inspiration by the spirituality of sacred verses and prayers. Influenced by early 20<sup>th</sup> century French and English choral traditions and steeped in the very best of English choral music, Rutter continues to inspire singers through his beautiful melodies, driving rhythms, and versatile writing style. The composition had its premiere in 1974 for Nebraska musician Mel Olson, under Rutter's direction. His *Gloria* offers a musical setting of the parts of the Latin Gloria, with the text structured in three movements and scored for choir, brass, percussion, and organ. While it is a liturgical text, it was conceived as a concert piece. Rutter credits Olson with the inspiration to compose it, saying, "Much of the credit must go to Mel Olson ... because, in telling me what he was looking for in a new choral work, he was telling me what thousands of other choral directors were looking for too."

The first movement is "Gloria in excelsis Deo" (Glory to God in the highest, the angel's proclamation to the shepherds as told in the Gospel of Luke. Opening with a fanfare, the brass and voices alternate with strong rhythms and triumphant shouts from the choir.

The second movement, "Domine Deus" (Lord God) is requesting mercy and prayers as Jesus is addressed as the Lamb of God. This movement begins with a haunting and spellbinding organ theme that leads to the choir offering prayers as the choir, organ, and brass build in intensity.

The third movement concludes the work with "Quoniam tu solus santcus" (For you alone are Holy), ending with a doxology (short hymn of praise to God). This movement builds, bringing back the text and music from the first movement, and then ends with a fast, furious, and glorious *Amen*.

The remaining pieces on the program include seasonal favorites by composers all the way from the 15th century (Lo, How a Rose) to current day composers/arrangers such as Dan Forrest and Howard Helvey.




