IV.B. Forms/Patterns Can Not Be Altered or Modified. Do not add or leave out kicks or movements. Doing so can result in disqualification. No variation from the above list will be accepted.

IV.C.2. 1st Dan competitors may do ANY Form/Pattern listed for Advanced or 1st Dan Ranks IV.C.3. 2nd Dan through 9th Dan competitors may do ANY Black Belt Form/Pattern listed for ANY Dan competitor up to and including their current Rank. (Ex. A 3rd Dan 2022 AAU Taekwondo Rule Book Forms/Patterns/Poomsae 37 competitor could legally do ANY of the 1st Dan 2nd Dan, or 3rd Dan Forms/Patterns listed for those Ranks.)

IV.C. Legal Forms/Patterns for Competition

IV.C.1. Novice, Intermediate and Advanced rank competitors may do ANY Form/Pattern listed for any of their previous Ranks as well as their current Rank.

Event Board Sizes Please Note: All Boards Must Be Purchased at the Event!

- 5 to 13-year-old athletes = Demo Small
- 14 and older athletes = Demo Medium

Repetitive Axe Kick

• Single break format; One board per strike. Allowed Technique Axe Kick – 10 board competition.

Winner based on time required to break 10 boards

Repetitive Side Kick

• Single break format; One board per strike. Allowed technique is side kick - 10 board competition.

Winner based on time required to break 10 boards

Repetitive Hand Technique (feeder hold)

• Single break format; One board per strike - Allowed technique is hammer fist - 10 board competition

Winner based on time required to break 10 boards
