EQUIPMENT:	All sparring competitors must wear WTF approved: white, red or blue headgear (red & blue headgear must match w/chest protector color) red & blue reversible chest protector, forearm guard, shin & instep guard, groin cup (Male only, worn inside) and white or clear mouthpiece.
COMPETITION RULES:	USAT and Organizing Committee rules will govern this championship w/emphasis on fairness and traditional martial arts values.
AWARDS:	Competitors: Medals (One) for 1st,, 2nd, and 3rd place.

#### Valid points for Kyorugy Competition:

- One (1) point for a valid punch to trunk protector
- Two (2) points for a valid kick to the trunk protector
- Four (4) points for a valid turning kick to the trunk protector
- Three (3) points for a valid kick to the head
- Five (5) points for a valid turning kick to the head, Black Belts 10+ yrs old Only.
- One (1) point awarded for every Gam-jeom given to the opposing contestant.

### **COACH'S RULES**

- 1. Coach or Master badge & Coach wristband required for all coaches. VIP, Grand master, etc. badge alone is not eligible to coach without wristband.
- 2. Coach attire: No hats, slippers/sandals/flip-flops; no jeans; no shorts. Otherwise, cannot coach.
- 3. Only one Coach is permitted on the competition floor with one competitor.
- 4. Coaches and competitors shall be seated and not standing at the ring.
- 5. Kicking pads are not permitted on the competition floor.
- 6. Assistant coaches and parents with coach badge are not permitted at the ring helping coach, yell or cheer.
  - Exception: may stay at ring to sit w/another competitor waiting to compete but, must leave competition floor if not sitting in coach's chair when match is called.
- 7. NO PICTURES OR VIDEO allowed on the competition floor without a Media Pass.
- 8. Waiting period for Coaches: Coach has 2 minutes to get to ring, otherwise match starts without coach.
- 9. Late coach can only enter ring in between rounds, not during round.
- 10. Coaches shall not enter or stand in center aisles or areas between rings, and shall remain seated always at the outer most portion of the rings on the floor or chairs closest to the walls.
- 11. Violation of any of these rules shall result in surrender of coach badge. Failure to surrender coach badge when first requested by the Referee Advisor, Referee Chairman or any Referee or Tournament Committee Member will result in removal from competition floor and Venue for that day.

Color Belts Sparring: Head Kick Rules: Light head contact for 12 and older color belts only.

**Black Belts Sparring: Head Kick Rules:** Only 18-32 year olds will be allowed full head contact. No head contact for 6-7 Black Belts. Light head contact for all other black belts.
