Sunday evening was a mix of emotions — encouraging for some, stressful for others. Teasdale Foods and its employees remain at odds over a newly proposed contract.

Pictured are members of the second shift, who expressed frustration over a clause that would allow the company to reduce their standard 10- to 12-hour shifts to 8 hours or less. For years, many of these workers have consistently put in long hours — six, sometimes seven days a week.

Chuckie Landers, a 10-year employee, says he's simply asking for fairness. While better pay is always welcome, he and many others are more concerned about protecting their current shift schedules, which are vital to their financial stability. We hope a fair deal can be reached soon.
