

Dress Code:

All dress expectations apply to campers, counselors, and parents attending camp. In order to maintain the intended atmosphere at all times, we ask that no one wear clothing that depicts anything that could be considered un-Christian or anything in poor taste. The Camp Director or Staff reserve the right to ask a camper to change their clothing if it is considered inappropriate. Leaders and Counselors, please pay attention to the attire of your *own* group and help us in these areas. Thank you very much!

Girl's Clothing:

Girls should wear modest dresses and skirts (when sitting the knee should be covered). Sundresses, low necklines, or split skirts above the knees are not allowed. Culottes can be worn for activities (when sitting the knee should be covered). Gauchos or long shorts that are called culottes by some are not permitted. Pants are not permitted. Bathing suits should be one-piece. Please bring something to wear over your bathing suit to and from the pool (boys and girls have separate swim times).

Boy's Clothing:

Boys must wear long pants. Shorts, jams, and skinny jeans are <u>not</u> allowed. Athletic and sweat pants may be worn for activities. Net, half, or sleeveless shirts are not allowed.
