The Medford Food Project helps people all over the Rogue Valley easily donate food to local food banks, including in our neighborhood. You simply sign up, and the neighborhood coordinator drops off an empty green bag. Then on the second Saturday of every other month you place your bag of non-perishable food items by your door. The coordinator picks up the donations and leaves an empty green bag for next time.
