We use Your Personal Data to provide and improve the Service. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Statement. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Statement.

Interpretation & Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions.

The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Statement:

You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to SUPPLYRLINK, LLC., 14316 Reese Blvd West Ste B, PMB 5108, Huntersville, NC 28078.

Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.

Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.

Website refers to SUPPLYRLINK, LLC, accessible from <http://www.supplyrlink.com> or other websites owned by SUPPLYRLINK, LLC.

Service refers to the Websites, products, services and programs owned by SUPPLYRLINK, LLC.

Country refers to: United States

Service Provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of SUPPLYRLINK, LLC. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the SUPPLYRLINK, LLC to facilitate the Service, to provide the Service on behalf of SUPPLYRLINK, LLC, to perform services related to the Service or to assist SUPPLYRLINK, LLC in analyzing how the Service is used.

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data
