Fasting

Fast days are shown in the Calendar – Fridays* and certain seasons. There are also fast-free periods.

Fasting should not be undertaken against medical advice. That would be a sin of pride.

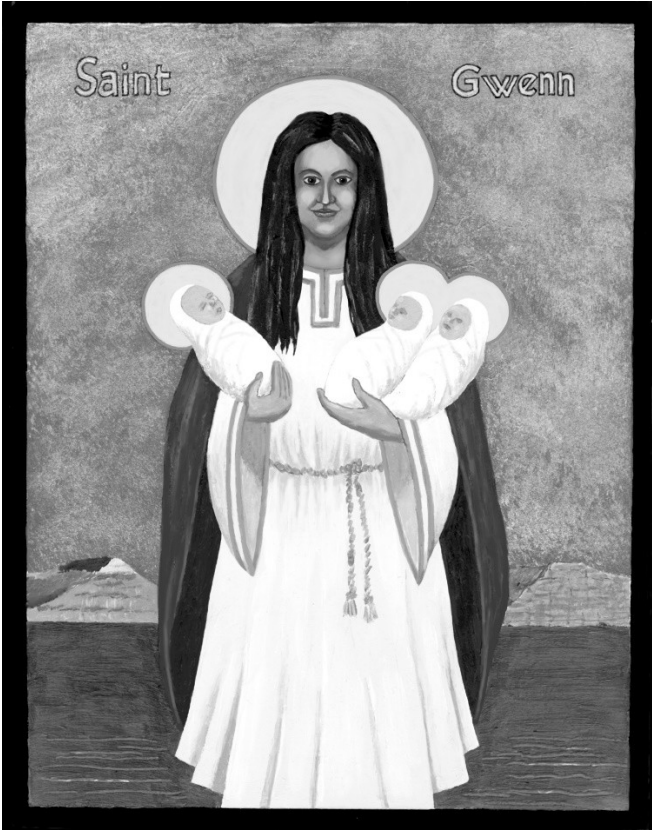
Fasting is intended to be a spiritual exercise, a way of focussing ourselves more closely on our Saviour and the Passion He bore for us. If not undertaken in this spirit fasting is devoid of meaning. Fasting should be accompanied by extra prayer.

The strict fasting rule of the Celtic Orthodox Church is to abstain from meat, fish, dairy products [in other words, all animal food and animal bi-products], and wine [alcohol]. Wine [alcohol] is permitted on certain days, such as significant saints' days, and fish is allowed on Saturdays and Sundays in Advent and on the feast of the Annunciation and Palm Sunday in Lent. For those who are able, Fridays would be just bread and water.

In the Celtic Orthodox Tradition the Dormition Fast is optional.

If we feel unable to keep a strict fast we should undertake what fasting we can, preferably having discussed this with our spiritual advisor or *anam cara*.

* Some may wish to fast also on Wednesdays in common with the wider Orthodox Church.

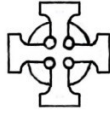
