You'll collaborate directly with TRXBE's Founder to shape the technical roadmap and make key decisions around architecture, infrastructure, and integrations. The ideal candidate is a builder with strong engineering fundamentals and full-stack experience.

Key Responsibilities

- Define and maintain TRXBE's overall technical architecture, ensuring scalability, performance, and security across all systems.
- Lead code reviews, mentoring, quality-assurance, and technical guidance.
- Build and optimize backend services and APIs using Node.js, Express.js, and TypeScript, with PostgreSQL (Neon serverless) and Drizzle ORM as the foundation.

- Oversee frontend architecture and ensure best practices in React 18+, TypeScript, TailwindCSS, and modern state management.
- Manage integrations with external APIs (Spotify Web API, Firebase, Google Cloud, Meta Graph, TikTok, and others).
- Establish DevOps processes, CI/CD pipelines, and infrastructure automation for smooth, reliable deployments.
- Implement and monitor data security, authentication, and user privacy best practices using Firebase SDK, Passport.js, Helmet, and related libraries.
- Develop and enforce coding standards, documentation protocols, and quality assurance processes.
- Collaborate with Product and Growth teams to support experimentation, analytics, and community-safety tooling.
- Prepare the technical foundation for investor readiness - ensuring code quality, infrastructure transparency, and scalability benchmarks.

- Strong architectural design and technical leadership experience—able to evaluate tradeoffs and make clear, strategic technical decisions.
