Rules and helpful hints for operating watercraft at Canyon Lake

Pontoon Rentals: Pontoon Boat Operating Characteristics and Rules

- You must be born on or before September 1, 1993 or have taken a boaters safety course
- Pontoons take time and space to maneuver, plan accordingly for turns.
- Never have passengers on the roof while motor is on or boat is underway
- No more than 4 people on the roof at one time
- No standing on the pontoon seats or jumping off the railing
- Any kid under 13 must have a life jacket on for the duration of the rental
- Check weather for wind and rain or other adverse conditions
- Make sure all passengers have life jackets properly fitted
- No glass or styrofoam containers are allowed
- Drivers are available and recommended for windy or rainy conditions or if the group plans on consuming alcohol
- Please do not attempt to drag or tow our watermats
- Be aware of scuba diver flags, stay 150 feet away

Jet Ski Rentals: Jet Ski Operating Characteristics and Rules

- You must be born on or before September 1, 1993 or have taken a boaters safety course
- Steering and Braking will not work unless the jet ski is on and power is given in a direction
- Must always wear life jacket with safety lanyard attached
- Left lever is brake control
- Right lever is gas for forward movement and steering
- Hold left lever in and give gas on right lever to reverse and brake
- If Jet ski flips over after making sure occupants are safe, you must make sure it is flipped back upright as soon as possible. To do this you must approach the ski and flip it at the rear right side. Grab the intake grate and step on bumper rail. Roll the jet ski clockwise. Display sticker is on the back to assist with rolling the jet ski.
- When finished, approach the boat ramp no wake zone at no wake speed, when you are approaching our employee look for further instructions. Do not shut off the motor before instructed to as this will cause loss of maneuverability. A Canyon Lake Adventures employee will grab the jet ski while getting off
- Stay 100 feet away from other boats and the shoreline
- Please do not tube or tow anything using jet ski
- Be aware of scuba diver flags, stay 150 feet away

What NOT to do:

- Bring glass or styrofoam
- Pick up additional passengers unless added to the passenger list
- Exceed boats recommended capacity
- Operate boat or jet ski in shallow water
- Drink alcohol and drive, (Drivers are available if group does not have a designated driver)
- Approach scuba buoys or divers, stay 150 feet away
- Speed in No Wake Zones or within 200 feet of any loading ramp
