Below are a list of the character qualities of God. The list is not exhaustive. I have found that it can be helpful to focus on a particular characteristic that has been a highlight to you in the season of life you are in.

for example to remind yourself that God is patient with us is comforting, especially when it has been a season of feeling like you are making the same mistakes over and over.

Read the list and choose one to reflect on and praise God for and to remind yourself of who He is.

Moral / Relational Qualities

- Love God's nature is love itself (1 John 4:8)
- Goodness All He does is good and for our good (Psalm 100:5)
- Faithfulness He keeps His promises and never changes (Lamentations 3:22–23)
- Mercy Compassionate and forgiving toward those who repent (Ephesians 2:4-5)
- Grace Gives undeserved favor and kindness (2 Corinthians 12:9)
- Patience / Longsuffering Slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love (Exodus 34:6)
- Kindness Gentle and benevolent in all His dealings (Romans 2:4)
- Justice Perfectly fair, always does what is right (Deuteronomy 32:4)
- Holiness Completely pure, set apart from sin (Isaiah 6:3)
- **Righteousness** Morally perfect and upright (Psalm 145:17)
- Jealousy Zealous for His glory and relationship with His people (Exodus 34:14)

- Sovereign Reigns over all creation (Psalm 115:3)
- Omnipotent All-powerful; nothing is too hard for Him (Jeremiah 32:17)
- Omniscient Knows all things, past, present, and future (Psalm 147:5)
- Omnipresent Present everywhere at once (Psalm 139:7-10)
- Eternal Has no beginning or end (Revelation 1:8)
- Immutable Never changes in nature or character (Malachi 3:6)
- **Transcendent** Far above and beyond creation (Isaiah 55:8–9)
- **Self-existent** Depends on nothing; the great "I AM" (Exodus 3:14)
- Infinite Without limits in power, wisdom, or presence (Romans 11:33)
- Glorious Radiates majesty and splendor (Psalm 19:1)

Personal / Relational Attributes

- Immanuel God with us (Matthew 1:23)
- Fatherly Cares for His children with tenderness (Psalm 103:13)
- Compassionate Feels deeply for our suffering (Psalm 34:18)
- Forgiving Offers pardon freely (Micah 7:18-19)
- Truthful Cannot lie; His word is truth (Titus 1:2; John 17:17)
- Wise Perfect in judgment and understanding (Romans 16:27)
- **Peaceful** The source and giver of true peace (Philippians 4:7)
