DO YOU HAVE HISTORICAL DATA?

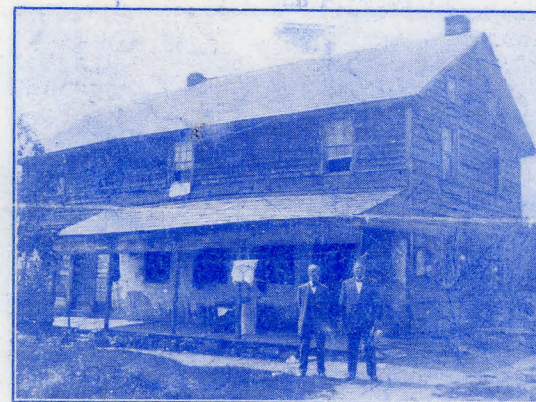
