INTRODUCTION

In 1914 the first reunion of this family was held at Edgemont Park in Lehigh Township, Northampton County, Pa. This was attended by about four hundred members of the family and friends; chiefly from Northampton and adjacent counties. A group picture of this reunion is extant.

Mr. Reuben R. Oplinger was elected the first president of the family association; and Elwood E. Oplinger and William H, Rinkenbach were elected historians. Later, Mr. John D. Watkins became an additional historian and collected much information prior to his death in 1956. Progress in accumulating historical data was relatively slow until about 1935, when legalistic methods were adopted. The wide dispersal and loss of contact with some branches of the family, as well as changes in the spelling of the name and the lack of interest in some branches, had made completion of the task almost impossible. Since then progress has been relatively rapid, lost branches were discovered in western Pennsylvania and the Midwest. Considerable assistance has been received from individuals representing geographically remote branches of the family.

Over the years interest has increased to such an extent that there are now four annual reunions in Northampton, Luzerne and Jefferson Counties, Pennsylvania and at Wadsworth, Ohio. Elwood E. Oplinger has served as president of the parent reunion for thirty three years. Under his leadership, the four reunion organizations in 1961 and 1963 cooperated to place memorial Stones in the graveyards adjacent to the Klein Brethren Meeting House near Harleysville, Montgomery County, Pa. and the Indianland Church (St. Paul's) at Cherryville, Northampton County, Pa. These mark the resting places of and honor the progenitor, Claus Oblinger his son Nicholas and grandsons Isaac, Samuel and Nicholas.

With the accomplishment of these projects, it seems appropriate that there be added another to mark the fiftieth anniversary of the first family reunion the appearance of this genealogical history of the family.
