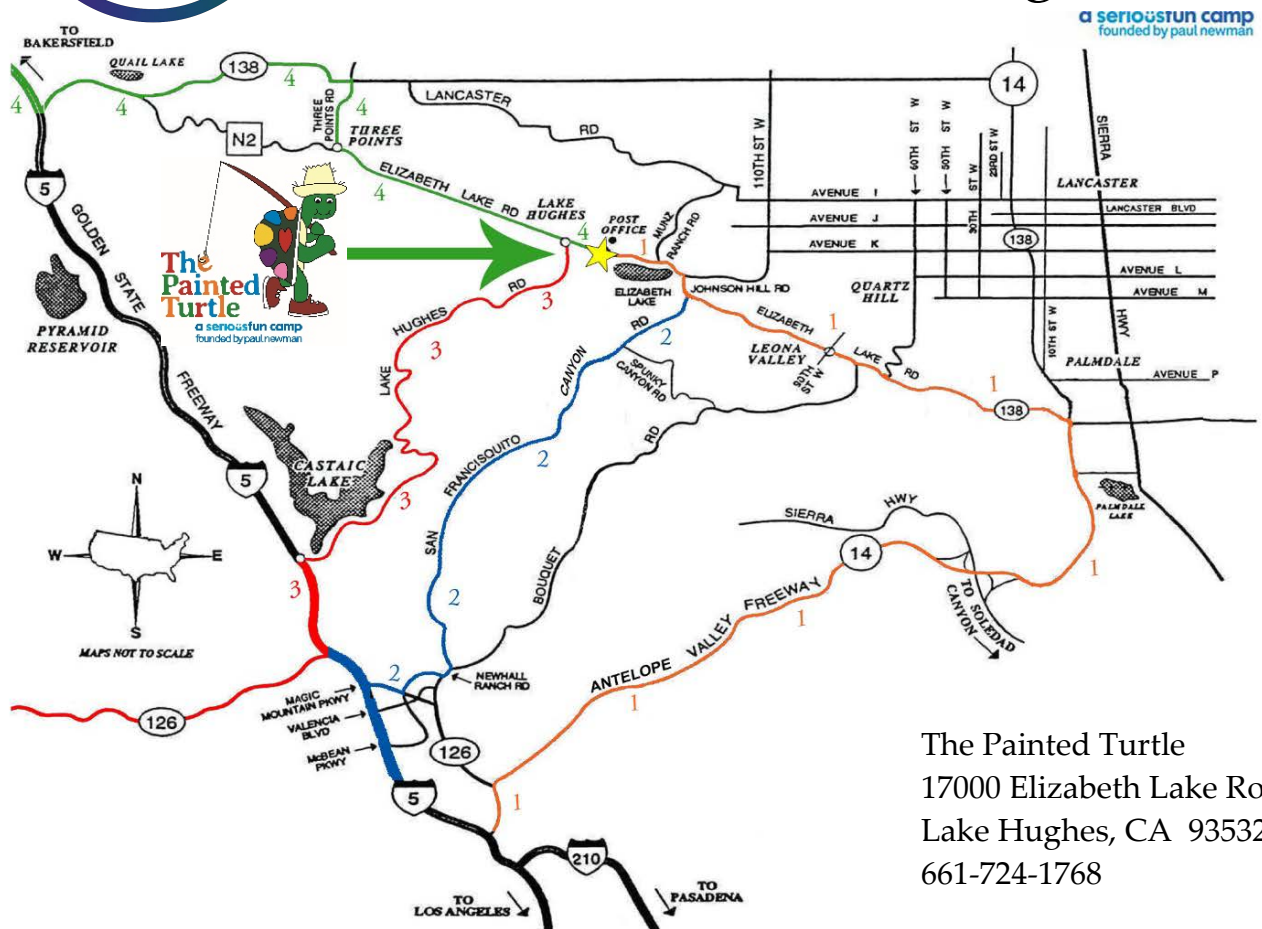




Directions to BLU Wonderland at The Painted Turtle in Lake Hughes

Los Angeles Area Drivers: Do NOT follow your GPS.

GPS will take you through windy canyon roads. Follow these instructions for a nice smooth ride to the retreat! (Route is indicated by the **brown** line on the map above.)

ROUTE 1:

DIRECTIONS TO THE PAINTED TURTLE FROM SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA VIA THE CA-14

- Take I-405 North and merge onto I-5 North.
- Take CA-14 (Northeast) for 35 miles.
- Take Exit 35, Palmdale Blvd./Highway 138 East, and stay in the left lane when exiting.
- At the light, make a left onto Palmdale Blvd, heading west.
(Note: You can follow your GPS from this point)
- Palmdale Blvd. will become Elizabeth Lake Road as you pass through the last traffic light at the intersection of Highland and 25th Street West (no turns needed).
- Continue on Elizabeth Lake Road for approximately 13 miles until you reach a "T" intersection (Elizabeth Lake Road and Johnson Road). Take a left (you will still be on Elizabeth Lake Road).
- From this "T," continue for about 3.2 miles.
- The Painted Turtle will be on the left, across the street from the Lake Hughes Post Office and Fire Station. Look to the left for the BLU Sign near the driveway .

Northern and Central California Travelers:

You should be able to follow your GPS, but the most peaceful drive is the one below. You might feel for awhile that you're in the middle of nowhere, however, it is a nice smooth drive. (Route is indicated by the **green** line on the map above.)

ROUTE 2:

DIRECTIONS TO THE PAINTED TURTLE FROM NORTHERN AND CENTRAL CALIFORNIA

- Take I-5 South to CA-138 (East).
- You will see a sign that reads "CA-138 to Lancaster/Palmdale."
- Bear right onto off-ramp to CA-138 East and go southeast for 1.5 miles to CA-138 East.
- Continue onto CA-138 East and go northeast for 13.1 miles to Three Points Road.
- Turn right onto Three Points Road and go south for 3.0 miles to Pine Canyon Road.
- Continue straight on Pine Canyon Road for 9.6 miles to 17000 Elizabeth Lake Road.
- The Painted Turtle will be on the right, **across the street from the Lake Hughes Post Office and Fire Station. Look to the right for the BLU Sign near the driveway.**

Inland Empire Folks...

You should be able to follow your GPS which will give you a direct route smooth ride to the camp. But, the easiest directions are below!

ROUTE 3:

DIRECTIONS TO THE PAINTED TURTLE FROM THE INLAND EMPIRE

- Take I-15 North through the Cajon Pass.
- Take exit 131 for CA-138 toward Palmdale/Silverwood Lake
- Turn Left onto CA-138 West.
- Stay on CA-138 West for about 38.5 miles.
- Bear left onto Pearblossom Highway
- Follow Pearblossom Highway, and drive for about 5.3 miles
- Turn Right onto CA-14 N, and drive for about 5 miles.
- Take Exit 35, Palmdale Blvd./Highway 138 East, and stay in the left lane when exiting.
- At the light, make a left onto Palmdale Blvd, heading west.
- Palmdale Blvd. will become Elizabeth Lake Road as you pass through the last traffic light at the intersection of Highland and 25th Street West (no turns needed).
- Continue on Elizabeth Lake Road for approximately 13 miles until you reach a "T" intersection (Elizabeth Lake Road and Johnson Road - there is a stop sign). Take a left (you will still be on Elizabeth Lake Road).
- From this "T," continue for about 3.2 miles.
- The Painted Turtle will be on the left, **across the street from the Lake Hughes Post Office and Fire Station. Look to the left for the BLU Sign near the driveway.**
