A mini Rioja, the attractive bright purple-tinged colour leads you to a nose laden with ripe cherry and a subtle hint of spice. Wonderfully round palate.			
<b>Shiraz, Rowlands Brook, South Australia</b>	4.55	5.95	22.95
Brimming with ripe fruit and a subtle spice. This is a good full-bodied all-rounder.			
<b>Merlot, Ladera Verde, Central Valley, Chile</b>	4.70	6.25	23.95
Great example of the quality and value found in Chile. Vibrant plum and damson aromas with a soft supple palate. A touch of spice, a fresh, luscious finish.			
<b>Bourgogne Pinot Noir 'Les Chapitres', 2023, Maison Jaffelin, France</b>	7.65	10.45	35.75
An expressive, polished style of pinot with pronounced red berry fruit and just a hint of oak. Powerful, yet supple on the palate with fine, smooth tannins.			
<b>Rioja Vega Rioja Crianza, 2021, Spain</b>			35.95
Ripe cherry fruit character on the palate with savoury notes combining together resulting in a wine with notable depth of flavour with a silky finish.			
<b>'Arbouse' Massif d'Uchaux, 2022, Côtes du Rhône Villages, France</b>			38.50
Massif d'Uchaux is one of the 'cult' villages in the Côtes du Rhône. A bold, brambly, juicy red with real character and great depth of fruit.

<b>2020 Selección de Parcelas Malbec, Penedo Borges, Mendoza, Argentina</b>			65
A wine of great expression, intense purplish colour with floral notes, red fruits and black fruits. Soft chocolate and mocha. Ripe tannins and balanced acidity, with a round long finish.			
<b>2010 Cardus de LA Cardonne MEDOC</b>			60
Sitting proudly on the medoc's highest plateau this stunning Bordeaux is a culmination of highly skilled wine making and the perfect limestone clay terrier that produces this 50/50 merlot and cabernet sauvignon Bordeaux, elegant, fruity, lightly spiced and superb wine of great expression, intense purplish colour with floral notes, red fruits and black fruits. Ripe tannins and balanced acidity with a round long finish.			
<b>2020 'I Colli' Chianti Classico Riserva, Bindi Sergardi, Tuscany</b>			67
Produced from 20-year-old vines, it has depth, weight and character and merits its 93 points from critic James Suckling. Hints of wild cherries.			
<b>2022 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Galets de Berthaude</b>			80
An 80-20 blend of grenache and syrah, this is a Châteauneuf full of pretty raspberry and red cherry aromas. Full bodied and rich.			
<b>2023 'Henry's Seven', Henschke, Barossa Valley</b>			85
This shiraz, grenache, mataro and viognier blend is a tribute to Henry Evans who planted the first vineyard of seven acres in the Barossa Valley 1853. Fruit driven Aussie classic, yet with class and depth. Excellent wine from a top producer.			
<b>2013 Reserva Especial Senorio de Sarria Navarra</b>			65
Deep brick red, attractive plum and dried herbs with lavender, coffee bean and oak finish.			
<b>2006 Château Lalande de Pomerol</b>			90
Voluptuous, well rounded with wild cherry fruit and a long meaty finish, This chateau's wine is impressive, ambitious and imposing...a serious "complete Bordeaux." - Stephen Brook
